Owner Experience Review

Owners deploy the 52 Pleasure from MTI for family cruises and weekend outings as frequently as they do for poker runs and competitive performance events. Several 52s have been built and campaigned specifically for poker-run

competition (notably the Black Diamond example), yet the platform equally accommodates high-speed leisure and sport-boat roles. Listings show these yachts being trailered and offered for resale, reflecting active owner-to-owner transfers and appearances at shows.

On the water, the 52 Pleasure is known for extreme top-end performance when fitted with Mercury Racing packages and M8 drives. Published figures vary, and after modifications some owners report speeds in the ~170–185 mph bracket. Owners note that despite being a large performance catamaran the boat feels stable at speed and the wide beam inspires confidence; one owner summed up the sensation: "It feels like you're getting punched in the chest." Another cockpit remark compares wind handling—"you get wind noise in the skater, but the MTI the wind goes right over you."

Layout and comfort tend toward performance-oriented simplicity: a six-seat open cockpit and a clean, uncluttered helm are common, while accommodations are compact yet reported to sleep up to eight in some configurations and many boats are personalized to the original owner's preferences. Typical propulsion packages include high-horsepower Mercury Racing gas setups (examples cited include 1550/1350 and reported 1650 variants) paired with M8 drives, which require specialized maintenance and carry higher operating costs than standard cruisers. Owner comments often reference recent engine refreshes or repowers, and an example fuel-burn figure reported is 48–52 gph per engine.

Pros and Cons

- Stable at speed for a high-performance catamaran, offering a wide-beam presence that enhances confidence.
- Cockpit wind management reduces noise and fatigue compared with some competitor designs.

- Flexible in use: well-suited to family weekend cruising, spirited high-speed outings, and poker-run competition, with interiors that can be customized.
- High-performance Mercury Racing engines and M8 drives necessitate specialist servicing and incur higher operational expenses.
- Owners report substantial fuel consumption, with an example burn of 48–52 gph per engine.
- Published top-speed figures are variable and typically depend on modifications and expert tuning to realize.
