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OVERVIEW

Crafted for comfortable, efficient cruising, the 62 from NAUTICKS is a motor yacht built within the fiberglass-and-plastic class segment. With a 62 ft (19.12 m) LOA and an expansive 32 ft (10 m) beam, driven by twin Yanmar diesels and supported by substantial tankage, it is designed for capable passage-making at a 9.5 kn cruising pace and a 13.5 kn top end.

Selecting a 62

Opt for the 62 if you prioritise economical passages, a shallow draft of 4.593–4.921 ft (1.4–1.5 m) for broader cruising access, and liveaboard functionality with five heads plus crew accommodation for two. As a motor yacht, it is well suited to private owners, family cruising, and small-scale charter operators who need a wide-beam layout with uncomplicated systems and generous capacity.

Features of the Model

- Dimensions and volume: 62 ft (19.12 m) LOA and 32 ft (10 m) beam create roomy interior and deck environments.
- Performance: Designed to cruise at 9.5 kn (10.93 mph) with a maximum speed of 13.5 kn (15.54 mph).
- Draft flexibility: Shallow 4.593–4.921 ft (1.4–1.5 m) draft for accessing a variety of anchorages and marinas.
- Power and fuel: Twin Yanmar engines running on Diesel for reliable propulsion.
- Capacities: Fuel capacity of 528.34 gal; fresh water capacity of 317.01 gal.
- Accommodations: Five heads and a crew area fitted with two berths to support extended operations.

Q: What type of yacht is the 62 by NAUTICKS? A: It is a motor yacht described as a motor yacht with a hull in the fiberglass-and-plastic class. This designation highlights its purpose as a **Motor Yacht** and its **Fiberglass and Plastic Yachts** construction.

Q: What are the key performance figures of the 62? A: The vessel is quoted with a **cruise speed of 9.5 kn (10.93 mph)** and a **maximum speed of 13.5 kn (15.54 mph)**, making it suited to efficient coastal passages and longer transits.

Q: How shallow can the 62 operate? A: With a draft of **4.593–4.921 ft (1.4–1.5 m)**, it features a **shallow draft** characteristic that broadens marina and anchorage options versus deeper-keeled designs.

Q: What accommodations and capacities support extended stays aboard? A: The layout provides **5 heads** and **2 crew beds**, supported by a **fuel capacity of 528.34 gal** and **fresh water capacity of 317.01 gal** to enable longer voyages and comfortable liveaboard use.

Owner Experience Review

Initial market exposure for the 62 by NAUTICKS has primarily come through Greek charter listings for the 2025 season, with examples offered both for professional charter operations and owner-run family cruising. The model is promoted for long-range/offshore capability (CE A) and for crewed charter duties, but independent owner testimonials and forum-style accounts about

long-term seakeeping and handling remain limited, reflecting its recent introduction.

Manufacturer and broker materials characterise the design as a semi-displacement power catamaran with a very wide beam and high initial stability, though those points come from seller claims rather than a broad base of owner verification. Published speed numbers vary between sources—cruise speeds are commonly quoted anywhere from roughly 9.5 up to about 14 knots, with a typical maximum reported at around 13.5 knots. Listings emphasise onboard comfort: a large flybridge that can include a Jacuzzi and upper-deck lounge, an expansive salon, and clearly defined outdoor living zones; the galley is described as fully equipped with a full-height fridge, oven/hob, microwave, ice-maker, and wine cooler. Accommodation formats differ between brochures and broker listings—one brochure indicates two master suites plus three double cabins (10 guests), while other sources reference seven en-suite cabins alongside crew quarters—so final layouts depend on the chosen build specification.

Regarding maintenance and service, standard propulsion is listed as twin Yanmar 6LY440 engines, and there are no widely reported owner threads documenting recurring mechanical failures specific to this model at present. Brokers note a 3 year GRP hull warranty with equipment covered under OEM warranties; however, published long-term operating-cost data and extended owner experiences have not yet become available publicly.

Pros and Cons

- Active 2025 charter listings in Greece indicate the model's readiness for professional charter or owner-operator holiday use.
- Onboard amenities such as a flybridge with Jacuzzi, generous lounge/salon spaces, and a fully equipped galley are aimed at maximising guest comfort.

- Standard twin Yanmar 6LY440 engines and a reported 3 year GRP hull warranty make maintenance planning straightforward.
- Independent owner feedback on sea-keeping and long-term handling remains limited for this recently introduced model.
- Reported cruising speeds are inconsistent across published sources.
- Variability in cabin configurations between listings complicates direct comparisons when selecting specifications.

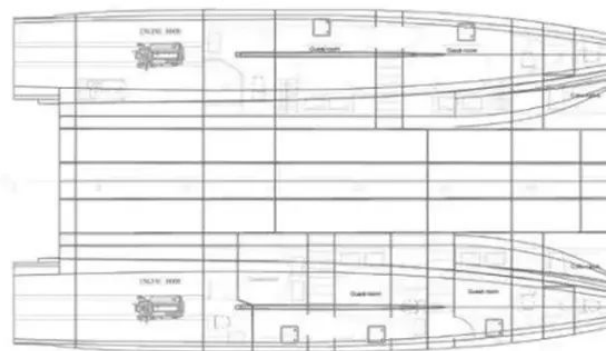




FLYBRIDGE

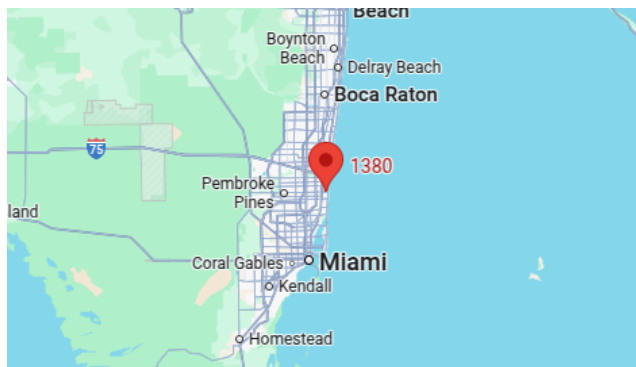
