## OVERVIEW

Purpose-built for flexible day trips, the Fastback from NORTH RIVER is a compact motor yacht constructed with a rugged aluminum hull and aluminum deck, powered by a reliable single Honda outboard. Represented professionally by Andrey Shestakov and the team at Shestakov Yacht Sales, this design delivers a blend of toughness, ease of use, and no-nonsense performance.

## Selecting a Fastback

---

If your priorities include a 25-foot LOA with an 8-foot beam, hardy aluminum build, and uncomplicated propulsion, the Fastback is a practical pick. Its single Honda outboard (gas) keeps systems simple and maintainable, while a 90-gallon fuel tank enables full days on the water. Q: What type of yacht is the Fastback? A: It is a **motor yacht** built on a tough **aluminum hull** with an aluminum deck, designed for straightforward day boating and utility use.

Q: Who builds the Fastback? A: Manufacturing is carried out by **NORTH RIVER**, a builder known for rugged aluminum craft and uncomplicated systems.

Q: What are the key dimensions? A: LOA measures **25 ft (7.67 m)** and the beam is **8 ft (2.59 m)**, providing a stable, compact platform.

Q: What powers the boat and what fuel does it use? A: The vessel is propelled

by a **single Honda Outboard** that runs on **Gas** , keeping maintenance and operation simple.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners routinely characterize the NORTH RIVER Fastback as a versatile, all-purpose platform. Captain Andy operates a 23' Fastback on Lake Erie for daily charters, and other owners deploy theirs on large lakes and offshore for salmon, tuna, and halibut, as well as for tournament runs and family tubing. In these scenarios, operators report a composed, stable ride in chop, rapid planing, straight tracking, and controlled turning, with rough-water handling that compares favorably to similar aluminum boats.

Onboard accommodations emphasize utility and comfort. Suspension helm seats—one captain described them as “like an air mattress”—reduce the impact of chop, while the enclosed cabin and self-bailing deck help keep crews dry and speed up washdowns. Listings and owner feedback also note a generous cockpit and cabin arrangement that swallows rods, tackle, and family gear, making the boat workable for overnight stays and tournament requirements when needed.

Maintenance observations are practical and uncomplicated: decks rinse clean, floors are free of wood or foam cores, and engine upkeep follows standard outboard intervals including routine 100 hour servicing. Dealers and owners point to responsive factory and dealer support and a lifetime limited hull warranty for the original purchaser; some buyers have experienced occasional build or order delays tied to supply chain issues. Public forum commentary has not identified recurring, model-specific mechanical failures.

## Pros and Cons

---

- Reported stable ride in chop and capable performance in rough water.
- Reaches plane quickly, tracks straight, and turns with control.
- Suspension helm seats, enclosed cabin, and self-bailing deck improve comfort and simplify cleaning.
- Some purchasers have faced build or order delays during supply chain disruptions.
- The lifetime limited hull warranty is valid only for the original purchaser.
- Requires routine 100-hour outboard service in line with normal maintenance expectations.
