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OVERVIEW

Presented by Shestakov Yacht Sales, the BS 160 Outboard by NOVAMARINE is a purpose-built performance motor tender in the motor yachts category. Built on a fiberglass and plastic platform with a GRP deck, it serves as a robust chase-boat or high-speed support vessel.

Selecting a BS 160 Outboard

If your requirement is a rapid, large-capacity tender either to serve a mothership or to operate independently as a chase boat, the BS 160 Outboard delivers. Its 55 ft (16.76 m) length overall and 14 ft (4.37 m) beam pair with a quartet of Mercury diesel outboards to deliver brisk acceleration and top-end performance. Expect a comfortable cruise at 38 knots with a potential maximum of 50 knots. The vessel's GRP deck and a sturdy fiberglass and plastic build underpin a durable platform, while a maximum draft of 7.655 ft (2.3333 m) allows operation in relatively shallow waters—qualities that make it a versatile choice among motor yachts and dedicated motor tenders.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and captains select the BS 160 Outboard from NOVAMARINE both as a dedicated megayacht tender/chase-boat and as an energetic family day-boat for coastal cruising. The layout emphasizes socializing: a spacious covered dinette beneath a full-width hard top equipped with a fridge, sink and a compact galley, plus a versatile bow area that converts between sofa, sunpad and dining arrangements. Down below, the dinette converts into a sleeping berth with an enclosed head and shower, and optional air conditioning makes brief overnight stays practical; brokers also point to a range of customization and high-quality finish options.

On the water, owners describe the craft as seaworthy and comfortable for extended coastal passages, able to handle open-water conditions and moderate chop while retaining a relatively shallow draft for beachside access and inshore exploration. Performance varies with the selected engine package: multi-outboard installations significantly influence acceleration, cruise feel and top speed. Typical cruise numbers cited are around 32–35 kn, with reported top speeds in the 42–50 kn range depending on propulsion choices.

Daily ownership reflects the realities of multiple outboard powerheads. External access to the engines is generally straightforward, but maintenance tasks—engine synchronization, propeller and gearcase servicing, and fluid changes—require coordination across several units, adding complexity and

higher annual service costs versus a single-engine arrangement. Independent owner feedback is limited; beyond manufacturer and brokerage information there are few public forum threads, and our review did not uncover any widely reported, recurring hull- or system-related defects.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile role as a megayacht tender/chase boat and as a family day-cruiser for coastal trips.
- Confident open-water manners and shallow-draft access support long coastal runs and beach-close exploration.
- Social deck plan with a large covered dinette, convertible bow, and a compact cabin with shower and optional A/C for short overnights.
- Multiple high-horsepower outboards add service coordination and increase annual maintenance costs.
- Performance character and top speed vary notably with engine selection and setup.
- Limited independent owner-forum reporting; long-term field data in the public domain remains thin.
