The 600 LX from NOVURANIA OF AMERICA is a compact motor yacht constructed on a sturdy fiberglass and plastic platform. Measuring 19 ft (5.99 m) overall with an 8 ft (2.72 m) beam, it offers a practical, no-frills layout ideal for straightforward days afloat. Owner Experience Review

Owners and skippers commonly employ the 600 LX as a true multi-purpose tender: it frequently serves larger yachts yet equally performs as a day cruiser, watersports platform, dive support boat, and weekend lake runabout. On the water it exhibits credible offshore handling for its size, giving lively, responsive performance; when equipped with a 200 hp outboard, manufacturer figures suggest a top speed near 48 mph. Guest seating is practical and comfortable, with wrap-around aft benches and a welcoming bow area, and resale listings often show yacht-level appointments—teak or flexiteak decking, a Fusion stereo, Garmin electronics, bespoke upholstery, and reinforced lifting points.

As a NOVURANIA OF AMERICA product, the helm layout and controls are often described as “yacht quality,” with touches such as a leather-covered wheel and beneath-deck fuel tanks noted in many listings. Maintenance trends mirror those of superyacht tenders: many examples report low engine hours and professional upkeep, though some owners have experienced nuisance

fuel level sender problems, and factory service is concentrated in Vero Beach, Florida, which can require shipping the boat for certain work. The use of premium materials—Hypalon Neoprene tubes and a cored fiberglass hull—adds longevity but also typically elevates repair and ownership expenses compared with more basic inflatable tenders.

Pros and Cons

- Pro: Demonstrates proven offshore sea keeping for its size, with agile handling and about 48 mph achievable with a 200 hp outboard.
- Pro: Highly versatile—serves well as a superyacht tender, day cruiser, watersports and dive platform, and a weekend lake boat.
- Pro: Yacht-level comfort and finish, including wrap around aft seating, usable bow seating, and upscale options commonly fitted.
- Con: Some owners report issues with fuel level gauges or senders providing inaccurate readings.
- Con: Service and repair can be centralized, and certain work may require shipping to the NOVURANIA OF AMERICA factory.
- Con: Premium components such as Hypalon tubes and cored fiberglass construction result in higher repair and ownership costs versus basic tenders.
