The Chase 38 from NOVURANIA OF AMERICA is a purpose-designed motor tender within the broader motor yachts category, built around twin inboard diesel propulsion and a sturdy fiberglass and plastic hull. Its 38 ft (11.61 m) overall length paired with a 9 ft (3 m) beam provides a useful balance of capacity and nimble handling, while twin Volvo Penta inboard diesels offer dependable performance and precise control. With a 226-gallon fuel reserve and 20 gallons of freshwater, plus a dedicated head, the vessel is equipped for comfortable full-day operations. - Q: What is the classification of the Chase 38? A: It's a motor tender within the motor yachts segment, constructed on a fiberglass and plastic foundation to maximize durability and reduce upkeep. This **classification** makes it well suited for superyacht support duties and premium guest transfers.
- Q: What propulsion does it use? A: The boat is driven by 2 x **Volvo Penta** engines in an **Inboard** configuration using **Diesel** fuel, providing efficient power delivery and agile handling.
- Q: What are the key dimensions? A: The **LOA is 38 ft (11.61 m)** and the **beam is 9 ft (3 m)**, creating a stable platform that remains easily managed alongside a mothership or within marina confines.
- Q: What onboard capacities support operations? A: The vessel features a **fuel capacity of 226 gallons**, **fresh water capacity of 20 gallons**, and **1 head**, offering the range, amenities, and flexibility needed for day-long programs.

Owner Experience Review

Owners commonly operate the Chase 38 from NOVURANIA OF AMERICA as a primary tender for a mothership or as a guest transfer and day-charter vessel; it also adapts well as a family weekender with capacity for larger groups. The layout accommodates seating for up to 21 passengers, including wrap-around bow seating and an aft sunpad, simplifying transfers and social cruising. Charter operators frequently report positive guest interactions, with one noting, "Once the tour started I could tell it would be a great day, the crew interacted with the guests and made us feel like family."

On the water, the deep V GRP hull is praised for delivering a composed, comfortable ride in open sea conditions and for predictable handling during embarkations and disembarkations. Performance varies with installation: the builder lists top speeds up to ~56 mph on more powerful engine packages, while resale listings typically cite cruising speeds around ~22–35 knots and top speeds in the 30–40 knot range depending on engine selection and drive configuration. As a result, owners match propulsion to mission requirements, from twin inboard diesels to commercially oriented outboard conversions.

Comfort and detailing meet expectations for a yacht tender: refined fixtures, a side-entry door with a removable boarding handrail, and a versatile deck plan make boarding from a dock or garage straightforward. Construction features vacuum bagged cored GRP, a solid glass keel, and foam encapsulated stringers, paired with service-friendly elements such as under deck aluminum fuel and water tanks with on deck fills and a well lit, accessible engine room. On the brokerage market many excellent tenders are described as well maintained, though higher hour examples are common, so buyers emphasize engine-brand support (Volvo D4/D6, Yanmar, or outboard packages) and complete service records.

Pros and Cons

- Deep V GRP hull delivers a smooth, stable ride suitable for open water guest transfers.
- Spacious layout seats up to 21 with yacht quality finishes and easy boarding features.
- Proven versatility as a superyacht tender, family dayboat, and commercial tour platform.
- Performance varies widely with engine and drive choices, so results depend on the package.
- Many used examples carry high engine hours, making service history

scrutiny essential.

- Parts and service availability depend on the installed engine brand.
