Owner Experience Review

Operators and crew commonly employ the LX 750 from NOVURANIA OF AMERICA as either a primary or chase tender aboard larger yachts, where it performs guest transport and routine tender responsibilities. The manufacturer lists the model as 7.5 m LOA with seating for up to 15 passengers, and it frequently appears on superyacht equipment lists (including Alfa Nero) because its quick acceleration, tight maneuverability, and predictable handling suit sheltered/coastal transfers and watersports support.

Service and upkeep follow typical RIB practices: the inflatable tubes and buoyancy chambers should be checked regularly for pressure and wear, and replacement of those components is an expected part of the maintenance cycle. Owners often reference the NOVURANIA OF AMERICA factory service center in Vero Beach, FL for tube repairs and genuine parts; some sale listings note recent tube renewals or engine overhauls as routine lifecycle items. Brochures and specifications show production and availability roughly between 2016–2025, indicating ongoing factory support; while one anecdote about a 12-foot Novurania RIB lasting nearly 20 years refers to a different size, it illustrates the brand's reputation for longevity when vessels are properly maintained.

Pros and Cons

- Well-established as a primary or chase tender for larger yachts, offering reliable guest transfer capability.
- Roomy seating layout—rated for up to 15—provides efficient, comfortable shuttles for a 7.5 m tender.

- Factory-quoted top speeds near 51 mph with an outboard or about 43 mph with an inboard enable rapid turnarounds and responsive operations.
- Inflatable tubes and flotation elements demand routine pressure checks, inspections, and eventual replacement.
- Tube repairs and parts support commonly route through the NOVURANIA OF AMERICA factory service center in Vero Beach, which can add logistical lead time.
- Best suited for sheltered and coastal tender duties rather than extended offshore passages.

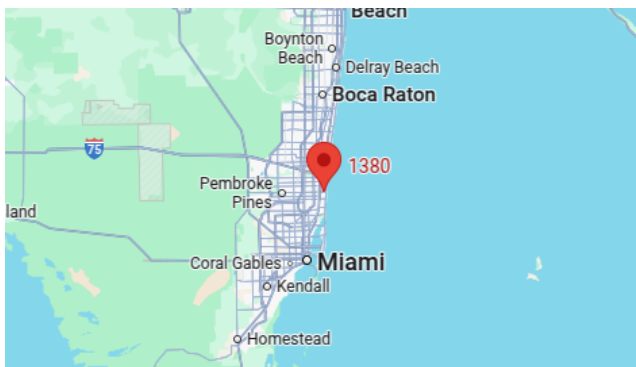
