Q: What sets the 83 Motor Yacht apart in the motor yacht market? A: It delivers

a mega yacht sense of scale with balanced **performance** , generous **accommodations** , and practical **crew** provision, all on a durable fiberglass and plastic platform by Ocean Alexander.

Q: How fast does it go, and what is the comfortable cruise? A: Expect a **cruise speed** around 15 kn (17.26 mph) and a **top speed** up to 22 kn (25.32 mph) under twin **CAT** inboard **diesel** power.

Q: How many guests and crew can the yacht support? A: The layout provides **accommodations** for 8 guests with 5 **heads** , plus 2 **crew** beds to maintain service and operations.

Q: What are the hull and deck materials? A: The **hull** is fiberglass and plastic for strength and efficiency, while the **deck** is Fiberglass for low-maintenance durability.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and evaluators characterize the 83 Motor Yacht from Ocean Alexander as ideal for a large cruising family, and practical for either owner operators or fully crewed operations. One owner relates a 12 hour non stop run from San Diego with only minor issues—"loosened up a few hoses, but not much else." During a tougher sea trial in eight foot conditions an expert observed that "the 83 dismissed them," and owners frequently report it managing 6' to 8' seas with reassuring, composed motion. The seakindly semi planing hull, featuring a fine entry and noticeable bow flare, provides forgiving slams and a relatively dry ride; optional twin Seakeeper gyros are available to markedly reduce roll underway or at anchor.

The interior layout favors extended cruising: a full beam aft master, mirrored twin guest staterooms to port and starboard, and a luminous forepeak VIP, with reviewers often complimenting the roomy saloon and galley. A commonly mentioned compromise is the main deck dayhead, which can impede starboard/aft sightlines from the pilothouse—some owners choose to remove or reconfigure it.

Serviceability ranks high, with engine room headroom exceeding 6'8" and a layout where "everything is accessible." That said, routine maintenance can be considerable—owners talk of "a lot of maintenance and repair" despite the hull and build being fundamentally sound—and little irritants like awkwardly located fuel tank sight gauges remain. Most boats offered on the market are 2008–2010 builds.

Pros and Cons

- Seakindly semi planing hull handles 6'–8' seas with a soft, relatively dry ride.
- Family oriented layout with a full beam master, mirrored guest staterooms, and a bright VIP.
- Versatile for owner operation or crewed use, with dedicated crew quarters and proven long run/liveaboard capability.
- Routine upkeep can be substantial despite a generally sound hull and build.
- Main deck dayhead can restrict starboard/aft visibility from the pilothouse.
- Fuel tank sight gauges are awkward to view for service checks.
