Represented by Andrey Shestakov and Shestakov Yacht Sales, the 85 E from Ocean Alexander is an elegantly appointed motor yacht constructed on a sturdy fiberglass-and-plastic hull. Measuring 85 ft (25.91 m) overall with a 20 ft (6.12 m) beam and propelled by twin inboard Caterpillar diesel engines, it combines assured seakeeping with spacious onboard living.

As a motor yacht on a fiberglass-and-plastic hull, she's rated for an 18 kn (20.71 mph) cruising pace and a 22 kn (25.32 mph) top end, while offering the onboard capacities needed for extended cruising. ## Questions and Answers

---

Q: What is the yacht type and hull of the 85 E? A: The 85 E is classified as a motor yacht built on a fiberglass-and-plastic hull. **Type** and **hull** are specified to provide a harmonious mix of seagoing capability and onboard comfort.

Q: What engines and performance figures does it offer? A: It is powered by two inboard **Caterpillar diesel** engines and achieves a typical **cruising speed** of 18 kn (20.71 mph) with a **maximum speed** around 22 kn (25.32 mph).

Q: What are the key dimensions and draft? A: The yacht's **LOA** measures 85 ft (25.91 m) and the **beam** is 20 ft (6.12 m). Reported **draft** spans from 16.404 ft (5 m) up to 19.411 ft (5.9166 m).

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners and brokers commonly describe the 85 E from Ocean Alexander as a family oriented long range cruiser. At displacement speeds, published figures indicate ranges exceeding 2,000 nm. While systems are engineered for owner operation, most examples are operated with a captain and a crew complement of one to three.

The layout and entertainment spaces—including a generous aft deck and a roomy flybridge (some walkthroughs reference an optional spa tub)—make the yacht well suited to weekend leisure, formal entertaining, and private charter operations. On the water, owners report top speeds near 24 knots with comfortable cruise speeds around 19 knots, although actual performance varies with engine fit; the Cat C32 is the standard installation, with MTU offered

as an upgrade. ABT stabilizers are frequently cited for noticeably reducing roll and improving guest comfort. Overall, the vessel's motion is characterized as long legged and sea kindly rather than aggressively sporty.

Daily life aboard leans toward a superyacht atmosphere: a full beam owner's suite complemented by typically four guest cabins, generous headroom throughout, and expansive salon glazing. Practical ownership considerations include stand up engine room access, a dry bilge configuration, and engine room camera systems that simplify servicing. Operational expenses align with expectations for an 85 ft yacht (genset use, main engine spare parts, HVAC maintenance), and some owners elect the higher performance MTU package; listings have referenced upgrades in excess of \$400k.

## Pros and Cons

---

- 2,000+ nm range at displacement speeds supports long range family cruising and extended passages.
- Predictable offshore handling with ABT stabilizers that reduce roll and enhance guest comfort.
- Full beam owner's stateroom and typically four guest cabins, with high headroom, large windows, and social flybridge/foredeck spaces.
- Running costs align with a typical 85 footer, with gensets, main engine spares, and HVAC adding materially to the budget.
- Top and cruise speeds vary by engine fit, and the MTU performance upgrade cited in listings can exceed \$400k.
- Tuned more for a soft, long legged ride than for sporty, high speed performance.

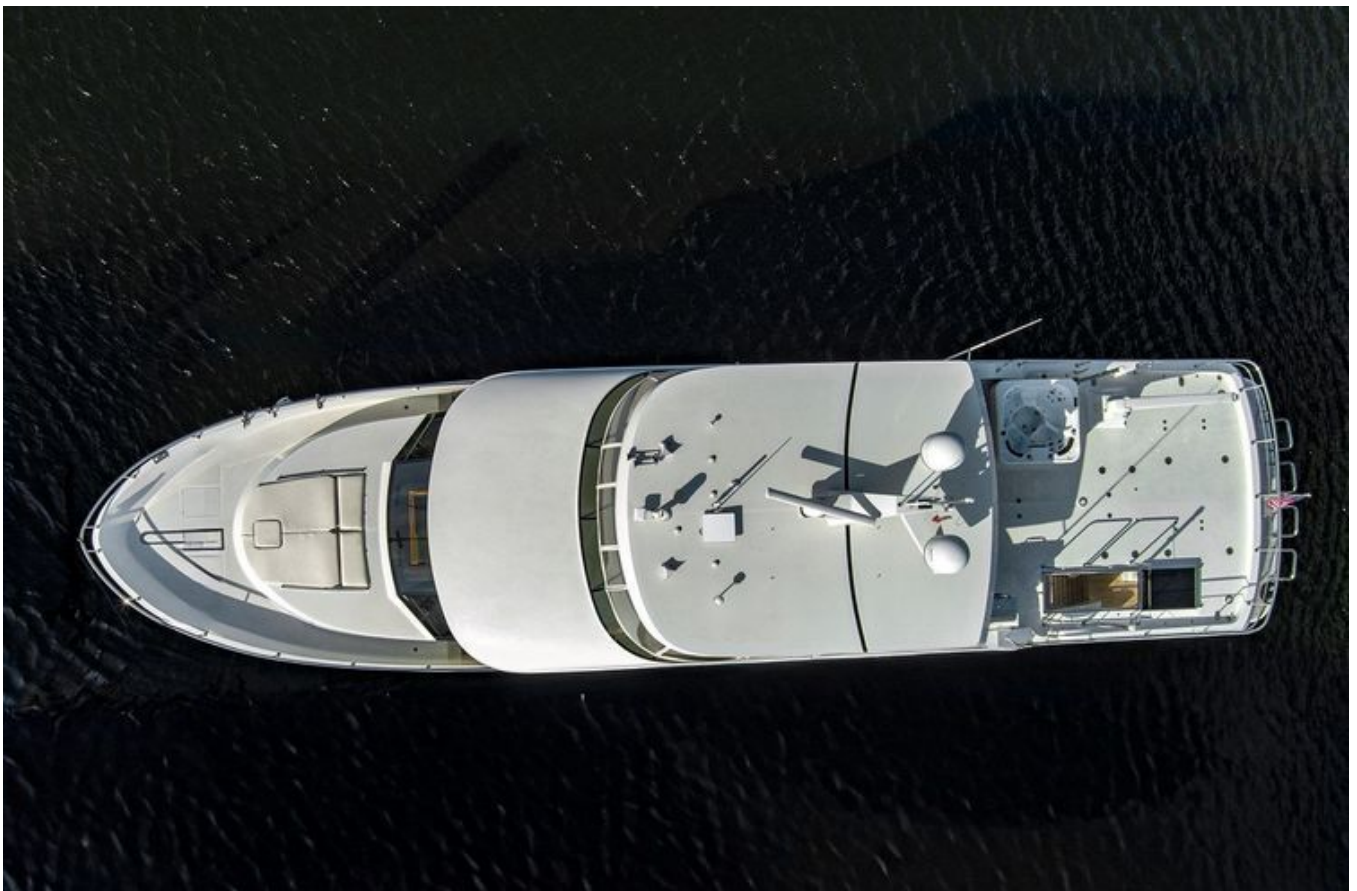
