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OVERVIEW

The 90 Skylounge from Ocean Alexander is an elegant motor yacht constructed on a reliable fiberglass and plastic hull. Conceived by Evan K. Marshall, it employs a Semi-Displacement hull form and Carbon Composite deck structures, powered by twin MTU inboard diesel engines to achieve a 16.5-knot cruising speed (18.99 mph) and a 22.5-knot top speed (25.89 mph). Measuring 90 ft (27.43 m) LOA with a 22 ft (6.83 m) beam, the yacht sleeps 6 in three staterooms, offers 5 heads and two crew cabins. 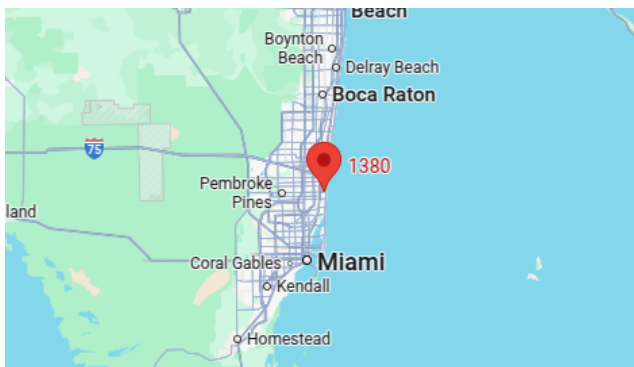
