OVERVIEW

The Doge 350 is an OCEAN KING-built motor yacht in the broader motor yachts category constructed on a heavy-duty steel hull. Measuring 114 ft (34.75 m) in LOA with a beam of 27 ft (8.31 m) and a maximum draft of 24.606 ft (7.5 m), the yacht offers 365 GT of internal volume. Naval architecture was carried out by Design aLOT, while the interior package was developed by Margini Architects. Twin MAN inboard diesel engines power the vessel, delivering a cruising speed of 12.5 knots (14.38 mph) and a top speed of 14.5 knots (16.69 mph). Accommodation is configured for up to 10 guests, supported by 7 heads and 3 crew cabins, and the boat carries 11,889 gallons of fuel and 2,642 gallons of fresh water. Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the Doge 350? A: It is a **motor yacht** that sits within the **motor yachts** grouping and is constructed on a **steel hull** platform.

Q: Who builds the model and who are the designers? A: The **builder** is OCEAN KING. The **hull design** is credited to Design aLOT, while the **interior design** is by Margini Architects.

Q: What are the engines and performance figures? A: The yacht is powered by **2 x MAN inboard diesel** engines. Its **cruise speed** is 12.5 kn (14.38 mph) and the **maximum speed** is 14.5 kn (16.69 mph).

Q: How many guests and crew can it accommodate? A: The vessel offers **accommodation for 10** guests, includes **7 heads** , and provides **3 crew cabins** to maintain professional crew operations and privacy.

Q: What are the key dimensions and capacities? A: The **LOA** measures 114 ft (34.75 m), the **beam** is 27 ft (8.31 m), and the **max draft** is 24.606 ft (7.5 m), with a **gross tonnage** of 365 GT. Fuel capacity is **11,889 gal** and fresh water capacity is **2,642 gal** .

Owner Experience Review

Owner-oriented commentary around the Doge 350 from OCEAN KING consistently presents the yacht as well-suited to extended family cruising, emphasizing a five-cabin arrangement and very large tankage that support long passages as highlighted in broker listings.

On the water the yacht behaves like a full-displacement explorer, most comfortable around 12–13 knots with top-end performance in the 14–15 knot band. The steel hull with a bulbous bow is often credited for improved seakeeping and steady motion, while owners note the usual efficiency trade-off: efficient and serene at long-range speeds, but significantly higher fuel burn when operating at higher speeds.

Walkaround and expert reports highlight onboard ergonomics and serviceability: a generously proportioned owner suite, an expansive main saloon, a galley with a substantial footprint for provisioning, broad exterior decks, plus clear separation between guest and crew circulation. Owners should also plan for proactive paint maintenance and corrosion inspection on the steel hull and aluminium superstructure, and expect a higher maintenance profile from systems such as multiple generators, hydraulic doors, and cranes—tasks best handled by experienced shipyards or a professional management team. Direct owner-forum feedback specific to the Doge 350 is currently limited, as the model appears new with 2027–2028 build years and most available commentary comes from brokers and the press.

Pros and Cons

- Five-cabin arrangement combined with extensive tankage makes the boat ideal for long-range family cruising and attractive for charter operations.
- Full-displacement steel hull with a bow bulb contributes to notable

seakeeping and overall stability.

- Large owner suite, roomy saloon, a well-sized galley, tender garage, and distinct guest/crew separation support comfortable, efficient extended cruising.
- Fuel consumption increases noticeably when the vessel is run above its most efficient long-range cruising pace.
- A steel hull paired with an aluminium superstructure requires attentive paint systems and regular corrosion monitoring.
- Complex onboard systems—several gensets, hydraulic doors, and cranes—raise the service burden and operating costs, necessitating skilled support.

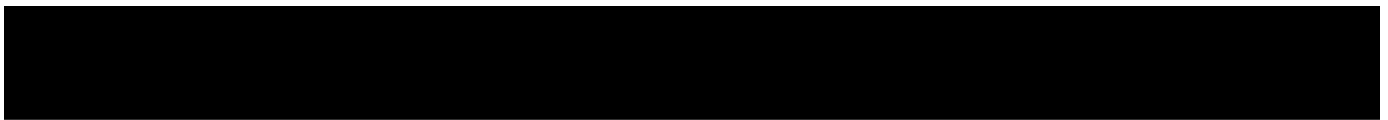

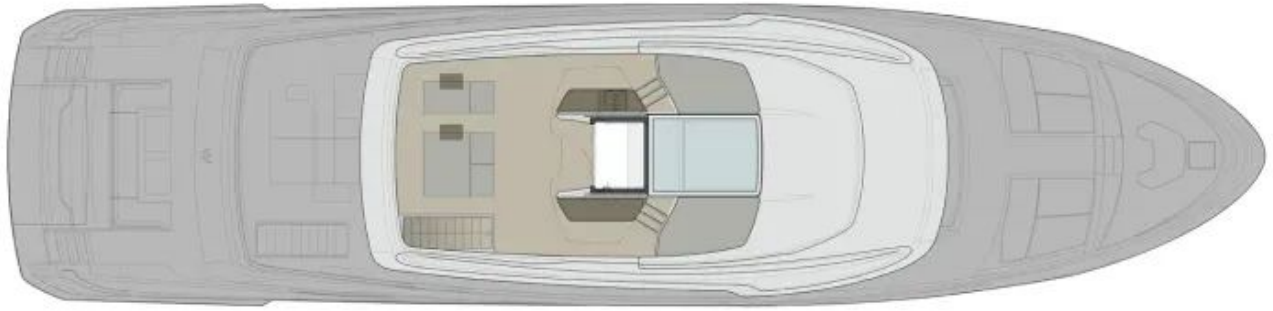
