OVERVIEW

The Ducale 140 by OCEAN KING is a 140 ft (42.67 m) motor yacht in the motor yachts category built on an aluminum hull. With a 28 ft (8.59 m) beam and approximately 440 GT of volume, it combines robust aluminum construction with efficient MAN diesel propulsion and generous tankage. Selecting a Ducale 140

Opt for the Ducale 140 when you require a 140-foot motor yacht built on an aluminum hull fitted with twin MAN inboard diesels and a performance profile centered around 13–15 knots. Configured to sleep up to 12 guests with five dedicated crew cabins, the design accommodates both private family cruising and charter-oriented operations where capacity and functional layouts are priorities. Questions and Answers

Q: What is the primary classification of the Ducale 140? A: It is a motor yacht within the broader motor yachts class and features an aluminum hull.

Q: What are the yacht's performance figures? A: The Ducale 140 has a **cruise speed** of 13 kn (14.96 mph) and a **maximum speed** of 15 kn (17.26 mph).

Q: How many people can it accommodate? A: The yacht offers **accommodations** for 12, with **7 heads** and **5 crew cabins** for operational support.

Q: Who builds and designs the yacht? A: OCEAN KING builds the model, and the **hull designer** is VYD Studio.

Owner Experience Review

Prospective owners attracted to the Ducale 140 from OCEAN KING are generally seeking true bluewater capability combined with comfortable liveaboard arrangements. Broker and technical sources indicate an approximate range of 5,000 nm at a 13-knot cruising speed, supported by a full-displacement aluminum hull engineered for a seakindly motion. The concept, paired with intentions toward RINA classification for unrestricted ocean navigation, places this yacht in the global-explorer category—suitable for owner-operators or fully crewed operations and adaptable for private charter use.

Onboard, the focus is on generous interior volume and subdued acoustics: published numbers list about 440 GT, with expansive floor-to-ceiling glazing and an insulation/engineering package designed for quiet cabins. Owner commentary from the Ducale range (referencing the 120-foot Vāyus) highlights that “I love the pool,” adding “we would spend practically the whole day

outside,” and even underway, “I would sit right next to it ... and never got splashed.” Those observations underscore the series’ emphasis on indoor-outdoor connectivity and a dry, confidence-inspiring ride—qualities the Ducale 140 aims to sustain.

From an operational perspective, owners will find a capacious engine room with direct access to twin MAN diesels and three generators, simplifying routine maintenance and troubleshooting. As the Ducale 140 remains a new/in production model with limited public owner histories, long-term reliability anecdotes are limited; anticipate conventional large-yacht upkeep—MAN service intervals, generator servicing, and regular hull/anode inspections for metal construction—backed by a thorough sea trial and professional survey process.

Pros and Cons

- True transoceanic range (around 5,000 nm) with an efficient ~13 knot cruise.
- Full displacement aluminum hull with RINA intent for unrestricted ocean navigation yields stable, seakindly passages.
- Generous volume (~440 GT) with floor to ceiling glazing and expansive outdoor areas, including a pool, supports family living and charter.
- Limited public owner track record as the model is new/in production.
- Metal construction demands diligent corrosion/anode management alongside standard MAN engine and generator servicing.
- Modest top speed (about 15 knots) prioritizes range and comfort over outright speed.

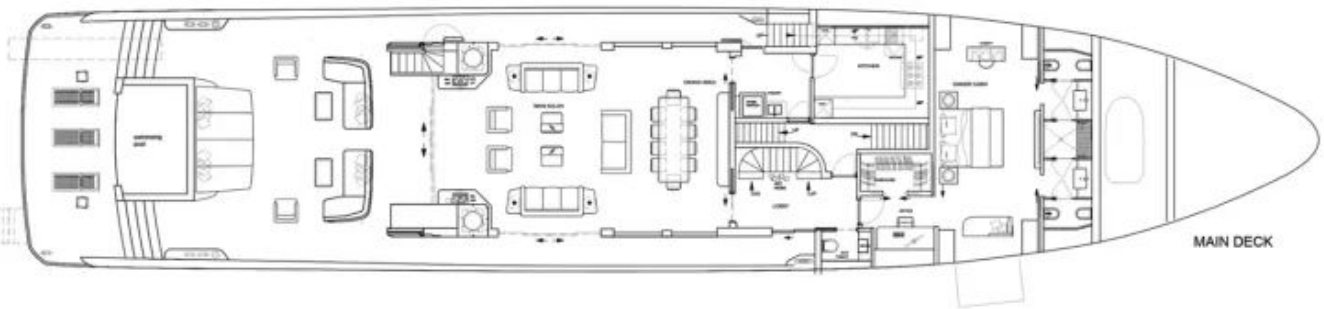
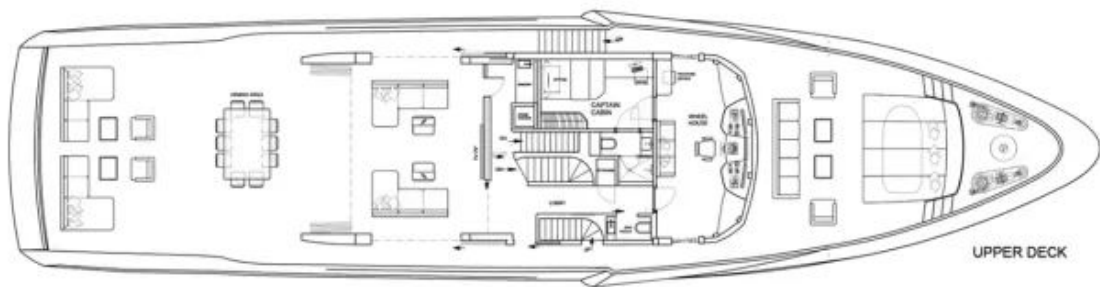
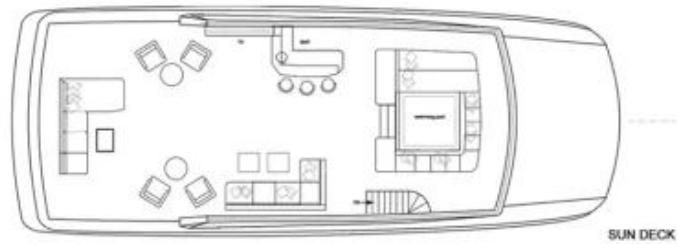
