OVERVIEW

The 48 Super Sport from OCEAN YACHTS combines the quickness and agility tournament anglers expect with the onboard comforts cruising families value. Built as a true sport fisherman and set on a robust fiberglass construction hull, it's a strong candidate for owners who split time between offshore runs and weekend getaways. Represented by Andrey Shestakov and the team at Shestakov Yacht Sales, the model is ready for confident passage-making and relaxed time aboard.

Selecting a 48 Super Sport

Opt for the 48 Super Sport when you need a compromise between dedicated fishing capability and comfortable cruising accommodations. Its 16 ft (4.88 m) beam provides stability and interior volume, twin MTU inboard diesel engines deliver dependable propulsion, and a 27 knot cruise speed helps you reach productive water quickly. Designed to satisfy tournament-minded anglers as well as family boaters, the layout sleeps three and includes three heads to make overnight trips convenient while preserving generous deck space.

Features of the Model

- Performance envelope: 27 knot cruising and 32 knot maximum speed for swift passages between grounds.
- Propulsion and fuel: Twin MTU inboard engines running on diesel for dependable, efficient power delivery.
- Build and finish: A durable fiberglass hull paired with a fiberglass deck for easy upkeep and long-term resilience.
- Layout efficiency: Sleeps 3 with 3 heads, utilizing the generous 16 ft beam for comfort on and below deck.

- Versatile identity: A capable motor yacht with focused sport-fishing purpose to match diverse missions.

Q: What type of yacht is the 48 Super Sport? A: It's a versatile motor yacht configured as a focused sport fisherman with a durable fiberglass hull.

Q: How fast does it go? A: The 48 Super Sport has a **cruising speed** of 27 kn (31.07 mph) and a **maximum speed** of 32 kn (36.83 mph).

Q: What engines power the boat? A: It's equipped with **two MTU inboard diesel** engines for reliable performance and efficiency.

Q: How is the boat laid out for staying aboard? A: The model **sleeps 3** and provides **3 heads**, using its 16 ft beam to balance comfort and utility.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and reviewers commonly describe the 48 Super Sport from OCEAN YACHTS as a true dual purpose craft that performs well for family cruising while standing up to serious fishing demands. Interiors on later models draw particular praise, featuring a U shaped galley up, a large L shaped settee, and a four top dinette in many examples, with typical two or three stateroom, two head configurations also common.

Salon and bridge ergonomics are frequently highlighted for generous sightlines and usable space, making the yacht well suited to 1–3 night weekends and island hopping excursions. Built from 1986 through 2003 with roughly 400 hulls produced, the model offers a wide spectrum of layouts and owner customizations, including options such as towers, outriggers, and extensive tackle centers.

On the water, owners report a comfortable modified V motion that rides well beam to and handles a variety of sea states capably, with numerous owners commenting that it “handles rough seas well.” Helm visibility is generally strong and handling feels responsive; some owners specifically note robust torque from Detroit Diesel 6 71 installations. Performance observations point to a mid 20 knot cruise and roughly 30 knots at top end, with brisk hole to plane

behavior aided by relatively low transom deadrise. In steep head seas, owners and brokers often recommend easing back on throttle for improved comfort.

Service and ownership notes reflect the model's production era and common powerplants: many boats were fitted with Detroit Diesel 6 71s that typically undergo rebuilds or re-turbo work over time, along with turbo replacements, manifold gasket renewals, and heat exchanger servicing. Routine genset maintenance and regular bottom work/diver attention regularly appear in maintenance histories. Given the span of vintages, prospective buyers should plan for age-related overhauls and confirm the exact layout and systems for the hull they're considering.

Pros and Cons

- Family-friendly interior with galley up on later vintages, a large salon, and common 2–3 stateroom, 2 head options.
- Comfortable modified V ride that sits well on a beam sea, with nimble handling and good helm visibility.
- Versatile platform for family cruising, weekend overnights, and sportfishing with towers, outriggers, and tackle centers.
- In bigger head seas, owners note it is best to reduce throttle for comfort.
- As a fleet built 1986–2003, many examples carry older Detroit Diesel 6 71s needing age-appropriate work like rebuilds, turbos, and heat exchanger service.
- Layout and features vary by vintage, so buyers should confirm specifics such as galley up arrangements and stateroom counts.
