Selecting a 52 Super Sport

If your brief calls for an offshore-capable craft that balances size, stability, and utility, the 52 Super Sport from OCEAN YACHTS deserves consideration. Built as a straightforward, dependable motor yacht on a tough fiberglass and plastic hull, it is supported for sales and service by Shestakov Yacht Sales and broker Andrey Shestakov.

Features of the Model

- A functional layout tailored to the needs of a true motor yacht, packaged within a 52 ft platform.
- Sturdy fiberglass and plastic hull paired with a fiberglass deck for longevity and easier maintenance.
- Single DDC/MTU propulsion package for simplified operation and reduced mechanical complexity.
- Generous fuel and freshwater tanks (860 gal fuel; 150 gal water) to support longer passages and autonomy.
- A 16 ft (4.95 m) beam that improves onboard stability and interior space.

Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the 52 Super Sport? A: It is a motor yacht constructed on a fiberglass and plastic hull by OCEAN YACHTS.

Q: What are the key dimensions of the model? A: The 52 Super Sport measures **LOA** 52 ft (15.85 m), has a **beam** of 16 ft (4.95 m), and a **minimum draft** of 14.217 ft (4.3333 m).

Q: What powers the yacht? A: Propulsion is provided by a single **DDC/MTU** engine (engine count: **1**), keeping systems simpler and maintenance more straightforward.

Q: What are the onboard capacities? A: Tankage includes **860 gal of fuel** and

150 gal of water , enabling extended cruising and offshore capability.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and reviewers commonly describe the 52 Super Sport from OCEAN YACHTS as a genuine sportfisher with tournament capability that also serves well for family cruising (model years 2001–2006). In moderate conditions she runs dry and composed, and can maintain about 25 knots comfortably into a 4-foot head sea; she exhibits gentle leaning in turns and can back down and pivot effectively when working a fish. Comfortable cruising speeds sit in the high 20s, while test boats fitted with higher-output MAN diesels reached roughly 38.8 knots; note that the MAN 1,050 hp configuration showed an observed spool-up delay of about 22 seconds during trials.

Below decks, the three-stateroom, three-head arrangement feels surprisingly spacious for the size, featuring a full-beam master aft and a forward VIP, while the stepped salon and galley layout makes efficient use of interior volume. Fit and finish receive consistent praise, with warm teak and maple joinery throughout. Above, the flybridge is arranged for socializing—ample seating, a molded centerline table, and optional bridge air conditioning—while the broad cockpit is configured for serious fishing with fish boxes, baitwells, and a sensible rigging workflow.

Maintenance access is a compromise: engine-room headroom is limited, there's minimal outboard clearance beside the mains, and a large diamond-plate battery box located forward simplifies battery work but can restrict access to forward-bulkhead systems. The heavy-duty diesel choices

(CAT 3406E, MAN 825/1050 hp, MTU 825) deliver strong performance, but come with the anticipated service and ownership costs. One owner also advised caution when lifting the yacht in slings—measure across the deck while hauling to guard against any tendency to "pancake."

Pros and Cons

- Dry, composed ride in typical seas with confident handling, including the ability to back down and spin for fishing.
- Flexible three-stateroom, three-head interior with a roomy stepped salon/galley and quality joinery throughout.
- Tournament-ready cockpit and sociable flybridge (optional AC) that serve both anglers and family cruisers.
- Engine-room access is confined, lacking standing headroom and with little space outboard of the main engines.
- Heavy-duty MAN/CAT/MTU propulsion packages bring the expected higher service and maintenance costs.
- Some MAN 1,050 hp installations were observed to have a notable spool-up delay of approximately 22 seconds.
