Q: What type of yacht is the 52? A: It's a motor yacht produced by OKEAN YACHTS built on a fiberglass and plastic hull. That positions it in the

power-cruising segment with a **composite hull** construction.

Q: What are the key dimensions of the 52? A: The **LOA** measures 52 ft (15.85 m), the **beam** is 14 ft (4.42 m), and the **draft** is 13.67 ft (4.1666 m).

Owner Experience Review

Owners are drawn to the 52 from OKEAN YACHTS for weekend family outings and sociable day trips thanks to an open-plan salon and galley framed by expansive glazing and the fold-out side terraces that open the cockpit into a larger entertaining area. The usual three-stateroom, two-head arrangement accommodates a family or two couples for overnight stays, while the often-cited “floating loft” ambiance keeps the interior feeling bright and spacious rather than confined. Underway, owners report a solid, steady ride at an economical cruise, with IPS joystick control simplifying tight marina work for an owner-operator. Reported cruise speeds typically fall in the 19–22-knot range with top speeds into the mid-20s, emphasizing efficiency and comfort over sprinting performance. Maintenance notes include routine inspection of the fold-out terraces’ moving parts, the regular service cycle for IPS pods and optional systems like DPS/Seakeeper, and appreciation for the cockpit-accessible engine room that’s arranged for practical servicing. Long-term reliability feedback online is still sparse given this model’s recent

entry into the market.

Pros and Cons

- Fold-out side terraces increase usable deck area for entertaining.
- IPS joystick control simplifies tight-space handling for owner-operators.
- Three-cabin, two-head layout works well for family cruising and overnight stays.
- Terraces introduce additional mechanical systems that benefit from routine inspection and maintenance.
- Cruising and top-end performance prioritize comfort and economy rather than high-speed capability.
- Limited long-term reliability information is available online due to the model's recent production history.
