Owner Experience Review

Owners favor the 46 from OUTBOUND as a bona fide passagemaker for bluewater cruising and extended liveaboard use. Underway it behaves much like a heavy displacement cruiser: it tracks well, maintains a comfortable motion at sea, and delivers consistent passagemaking speeds in the 7–8 knot range. Reports from owners include successful ocean crossings and dependable heavy weather performance; some note it can feel somewhat rolly in certain beam sea conditions, but remains seaworthy and forgiving.

On a daily basis the interior feels roomy for a 46 foot yacht, typically arranged with two cabins, a commodious saloon, plentiful storage, and a galley set up for extended life at sea. Many boats are equipped with a protected cockpit and optional hard dodger—features that owners value for long passages and liveaboard comfort. When not crossing oceans, the [46] is frequently used for coastal cruising, family outings, and club cruising.

Feedback from owners and surveyors underscores the boat's ease of maintenance: routine inspections should focus on stay bases, track bolts, and bedding to check for moisture intrusion, while access to systems is often excellent thanks to a walk-in cockpit lazarette that commonly houses a workbench and room for spare gear. Numerous owners invest in periodic refits and upgrades, with electrical, solar, and battery system improvements among the most common projects.

Pros and Cons

- Sea kindly motion and steady tracking make it well suited to offshore passages.
- Interior geared for liveaboard use with generous storage, a functional galley, and two cabin arrangements.
- Walk in cockpit lazarette with service area/workbench simplifies access to systems.
- Not built for speed; typical passagemaking speeds hover around 7–8 knots.
- Can exhibit a bit more roll than some when struck by beam seas, according to owner feedback.
- Surveyors and owners recommend checking deck hardware bases, track fastenings, and bedding for potential moisture ingress.
