Q: What type of yacht is the 800 MY? A: It is a motor yacht in the motor yachts range, built on a fiberglass and plastic yachts hull. It is characterized by a robust construction and a practical cruising layout.

Owner Experience Review

Owners tend to choose the 800 MY from OUTER REEF YACHTS for extended family cruising and genuine owner-operator passagemaking. Reports from actual voyages cite long runs—such as trips from Vancouver to Sitka, AK—alongside weekend use and liveaboard lifestyle, frequently incorporating owner-led customizations geared toward long-range cruising. Its displacement, CE Category A design, and long-range orientation support expedition-style routing with confidence.

On passage, owners report consistent cruise speeds in the 8.5 to 10 knot range and a maximum near 14.5 knots. Reviews and owner feedback describe it as fuel-efficient to run and straightforward to handle, delivering a stable, comfortable ride even over extended passages. Handling comments commonly note reliable tracking and a lack of shimmy or abrupt motion.

Onboard fit-and-finish and ergonomics receive regular praise—experts have described the finishes as "meticulous"—especially the functional, well-executed galley and the roomy accommodation layout. Machinery spaces are arranged to reduce noise for comfortable liveaboard operation, with owner-friendly access for routine maintenance. Post-delivery support from OUTER REEF YACHTS is noted as strong. Typical maintenance expectations for an 80-foot semi-custom yacht—generators, stabilizers, watermakers, and teak—apply, and there are no commonly reported single-design failures that dominate owner concerns.

- Efficient at displacement cruise speeds and straightforward to maneuver in tight spaces.
- Machinery access is owner-friendly and the builder provides reliable post-delivery support.
- Performance emphasizes fuel economy over high speed, with a top speed near 14.5 knots.
- Ongoing service and parts costs align with expectations for an 80-foot semi-custom yacht.
- Equipment such as generators, stabilizers, watermakers, and teak decking will require regular maintenance.

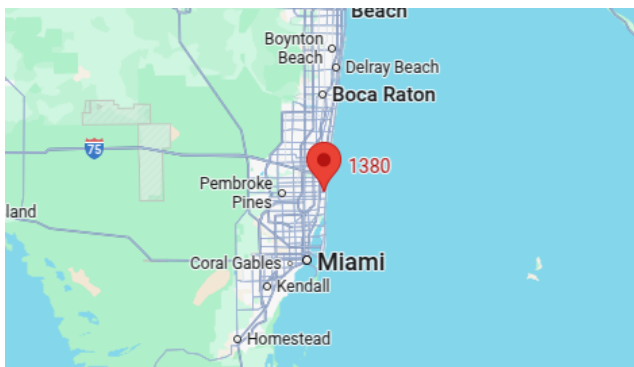
