Q: What is the exact type of the 65 Motor Yacht? A: The 65 Motor Yacht is classified as a motor yacht in the Motor Yacht class, constructed on a fiberglass

hull by PACIFIC MARINER.

Q: What are the key performance figures? A: The yacht's **cruising speed** is around 18 kn (20.71 mph) with a **maximum speed** near 22 kn (25.32 mph), powered by **2 x DDC/MTU** inboard diesel engines.

Owner Experience Review

Owners frequently choose the 65 Motor Yacht from PACIFIC MARINER for its ease of single handed operation and predictable seakeeping. Feedback commonly praises the yacht's handling and ride quality — summarised often as "handles, rides, and runs so beautifully" — attributed to the William Garden modified V hull and a moderate aft deadrise that gives a comfortable, sea-kindly motion.

Inside, the three-stateroom layout is noted for providing practical separation of spaces: a bright salon with expansive windows and a sliding glass door creates smooth flow for entertaining, while the galley and dinette forward on the pilothouse level support casual meal service. The full beam master, featuring a king berth and a tub, is regularly singled out as a standout cabin.

Multiple dining and lounging areas make the yacht well suited to family cruising and extended trips, though owners caution that the side decks are somewhat narrow and require careful footwork when moving forward.

Real-world use shows the model's versatility and range: owner-operated cruises from areas like the Chesapeake Bay to the Bahamas are common, and some owners have chosen to live aboard long-term — one 2000 hull (#14) has been full time since 2015. Maintenance realities are front-of-mind for owners: the cockpit sole hatch provides access to an engine room with standing headroom that facilitates hands-on servicing, and owners stress diligent upkeep. Recurring maintenance items reported include GB/cold plate refrigeration boxes that often get replaced during refits, and occasional turbo or raw water aftercooler issues that can cause black smoke or restricted RPM until cores are cleaned or parts serviced.

Pros and Cons

- Sea-kindly motion with reported low 20 knot cruising and approximately 26–27 knot top speed on typical 800–825 hp installations.
- Pilothouse designed for owner operation with strong port/starboard visibility and ergonomic helm layout.
- Generous three stateroom configuration with an airy salon and a full beam master, plus several dining and seating options.
- Side decks are relatively narrow, so exterior movement requires attention.
- Owners frequently encounter GB/cold plate refrigeration boxes that often prompt system refits.
- Some owners have reported black smoke or restricted RPM related to turbo/aftercooler maintenance needs.
