OVERVIEW

The 82 from PEARL MOTOR YACHTS is a sophisticated motor yacht built on a sturdy fiberglass and plastic hull, marrying assured performance with contemporary interiors by Kelly Hoppen Interiors. Listed by Andrey Shestakov and the Shestakov Yacht Sales team, it is aimed at owners who prioritize speed, onboard comfort, and intelligent layout solutions.

Selecting a 82

Opting for the 82 means choosing a multi-role motor yacht that harmonizes velocity, interior volume, and finish quality. Capable of a 24-knot cruise and a 32-knot top speed, powered by twin MAN inboard diesel units, and measuring 82 ft overall with a 20 ft beam, it's well suited to family cruising and entertaining. Onboard convenience is enhanced by four heads and a dedicated crew cabin, while the fiberglass deck complements the fiberglass and plastic hull for longevity and low maintenance. The Kelly Hoppen Interiors fit-out brings signature contemporary calm to the living spaces. Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the 82? A: It's a motor yacht constructed on a resilient fiberglass and plastic hull, offering a blend of performance and creature comforts.

Q: How fast does it go? A: The 82 delivers a **cruise speed** of 24 kn (27.62 mph) and a **max speed** of 32 kn (36.83 mph).

Q: What engines power the yacht? A: It features 2 **MAN** engines installed as **Inboard** units and running on **Diesel** for reliable propulsion.

Q: Who designed the interior? A: The interior is by **Kelly Hoppen Interiors** , which imparts a clean, contemporary sensibility throughout the yacht.

Q: What onboard amenities stand out? A: Notable comforts include **4 heads** , **1 crew cabin** , a **fiberglass** deck, and significant fuel (**1661 gal**) and water (**370 gal**) tanks to support extended cruising.

Owner Experience Review

Early use of the 82 highlights three principal owner profiles: family-focused owners who cruise privately, vessels operated with a captain for boutique charter, and short-break hosts who prioritize toys and day-boat style entertaining. The interior plan supports these roles: a main-deck, full-beam owner stateroom with direct access to a secluded foredeck terrace — noted as uncommon at this length — complemented by four further guest cabins within the five-cabin arrangement, plus three crew cabins for operational flexibility. Social areas feel open and airy thanks to extensive saloon glazing, a forward dining table seating roughly ten, and the option of Kelly Hoppen finish packages (Indulgence, Luxury, Modern).

Up on the flybridge there's space for full-size alfresco dining and a wet bar,

with an optional hot tub available, while aft buyers can specify Riviera or Veranda layouts; fold-down wings increase cockpit breadth. The tender garage is dimensioned to accept a Williams SportJet up to about a 345 model alongside a PWC, reflecting the design's emphasis on weekend use and carrying water toys.

When underway owners and captains should expect twin MAN V12 packages (rated approximately 1,650–2,000 hp) delivering quoted top speeds in the low 30-knot band (~32–33 kt depending on configuration). The hull has been developed with CFD input to enhance seakeeping and deliver a settled cruise, and the raised pilothouse improves sightlines. Feedback from press and sea trials at the Cannes 2024 debut suggested the yacht performs credibly, though as always early independent numbers can vary from manufacturer quotes.

From an ownership perspective, PEARL MOTOR YACHTS supports the 82 with a full five-year warranty, a notable reassurance given the model's 2024 launch and correspondingly limited long-term owner feedback. Crew and service access is routed to the port side to preserve guest privacy, press reports referenced straightforward engine-room access, and to date there are no major failure or recall trends reported. Prospective owners should budget for standard MAN V12 maintenance schedules and associated costs typical for a 25 m planing yacht.

Pros and Cons

- Main-deck owner suite with direct access to a private foredeck terrace is a standout feature in this size class.
- Versatile social areas with Riviera or Veranda aft arrangements and fold-down bulwarks to expand entertaining possibilities.
- Supported by a comprehensive five-year warranty from PEARL MOTOR YACHTS.

- Limited long-term owner data exists because the 82 launched in 2024.
- Early sea-trial reporting indicates that real-world measured performance can differ from the quoted specifications.
- The aft garage accommodates a Williams SportJet up to ~345 plus a PWC, which places limits on tender size.
