The 2021 by PIRELLI PZERO is a performance focused motor yacht built on a tested fiberglass and plastic platform and styled by the Mannerfelt Design Team. Opting for the 2021 signals a commitment to speed, sharp handling, and premium build standards from PIRELLI PZERO. Designed around a Fast Displacement Hull by the Mannerfelt Design Team and powered by a single Volvo Penta, this yacht offers assured cruising at 45 knots with exhilarating top-end performance up to 60 knots. For buyers who want a streamlined, performance oriented motor yacht built on resilient fiberglass and plastic construction, this model is a compelling choice.

Questions and Answers

- What type of yacht is the 2021? It is a high performance motor yacht from PIRELLI PZERO built with a fiberglass and plastic hull and featuring a Fast Displacement Hull. **Type** : performance motor yacht.
- How fast does it go? The 2021 achieves a **cruising speed** of 45 kn (51.78 mph) and a **top speed** of 60 kn (69.05 mph), with performance tuning from the

Mannerfelt Design Team.

- What engine does it use? The yacht is driven by a **single Volvo Penta** engine, offering brisk responsiveness and simplified servicing. **Engine count** : 1.
- Who designed it? Both the **hull** and **interior** were executed by the Mannerfelt Design Team, ensuring continuity between performance characteristics and onboard aesthetics.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and skippers commonly use the 2021 by PIRELLI PZERO as a walk around day boat, a high performance weekend craft, and as a tender or chase boat for larger yachts. On the water it behaves like a driver's machine: the reactive, twin step hull delivers nimble handling, maintains composure in head seas, and with suitable power has been reported to cruise near 45 knots while remaining unmistakably striking.

Deck life is prioritized. The largely enclosed cockpit is built for social days aboard, featuring a substantial wet bar (with multiple fridges and an ice maker), a six person dinette that converts into an extended sunpad, and secure walk around side decks. Below decks, a compact but practical cabin includes a double berth and a head with shower, making short overnight trips and weekend stays feasible.

Maintenance varies with the selected driveline. Typical configurations range from inboard Volvo Penta D6 units with IPS to triple large outboards such as Mercury Verado V10/500R; owners and community forums highlight that IPS maintenance can be costly (one owner cited roughly a €4,300 service at 5 years/800 hours, lift not included), while triple outboards add service

complexity and spare parts expenses. As with any RIB, regular care of the tubes — cleaning, UV protection, and frequent inspections — extends longevity.

Pros and Cons

- Sporty, responsive twin step hull that rewards drivers who engage with the boat.
- Spacious, well enclosed deck arrangement with a wet bar, multiple fridges/ice maker, and a dinette that converts to a sunpad.
- Multifaceted capability: excellent for day cruising, chase boat roles, and high speed leisure.
- IPS driveline entails notable scheduled service expenses; one owner reported about €4,300 at 5 years/800 hours (lift excluded).
- Triple large outboard setups increase maintenance complexity and parts costs.
- RIB tubes require ongoing cleaning, UV protection, and inspections to remain in peak condition.

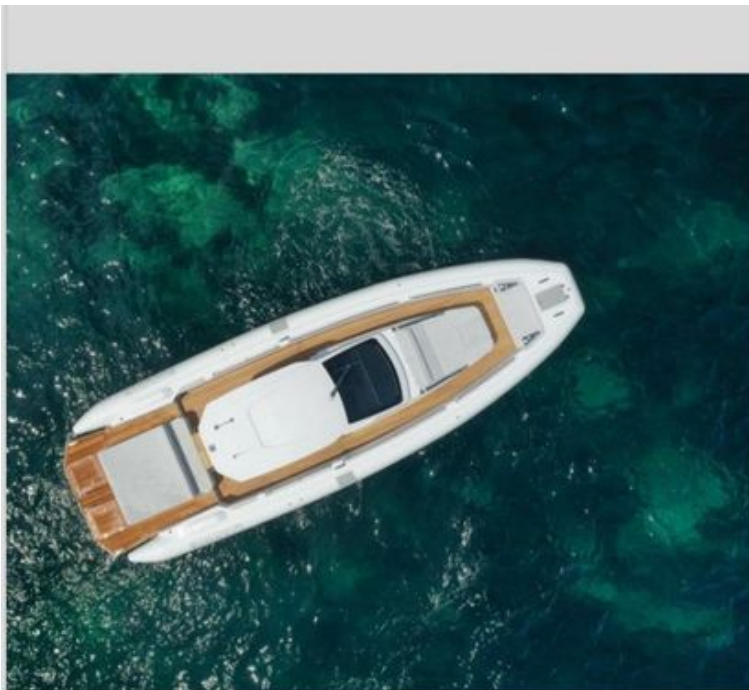
