Discover the 95S from POSILLIPO, a sport-oriented motor yacht built on a sturdy fiberglass and plastic hull. This model is offered through Shestakov Yacht Sales with broker Andrey Shestakov handling representation.

As a motor yacht crafted by POSILLIPO, the 95S balances speed, range, and guest capacity for extended family passages with professional crew support.

Features of the Model

- A performance-minded hull delivering a comfortable cruise at 23 kn and a maximum speed near 30 kn, suited to confident coastal and offshore passages.
- Accommodation configured for eight guests with five heads, complemented by crew quarters capable of housing four crew members.
- Built on a fiberglass and plastic hull with fiberglass decking and a traditional monohull layout for predictable seakeeping.
- Generous fuel and freshwater tanks to enable longer legs between ports and marinas.
- Full brokerage support from Shestakov Yacht Sales and broker Andrey Shestakov for purchase planning, inspections, and delivery logistics.

Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the 95S? A: It is a motor yacht constructed with a fiberglass and plastic hull, engineered to provide both **performance** and **comfort** for owners who want spirited cruising without sacrificing accommodations.

Q: How fast can it go and what is the optimal cruising speed? A: Typical operation places the yacht at a **23 kn** cruise (roughly **26.47 mph**) with a top capability of about **30 kn** (approximately **34.52 mph**) for faster transits when conditions allow.

Q: How many guests and crew can stay onboard comfortably? A: The interior is arranged to sleep **8 guests** and includes **5 heads** , while the crew section contains **2 cabins** with **4 beds** , delivering clear separation between guest spaces and service areas for privacy and efficient operation.

Q: What are the engine and fuel details? A: Propulsion is provided by **2 x MTU** diesel engines. Fuel storage is approximately **2905.89 gal** and fresh water capacity is around **1056.69 gal** , supporting extended cruising ranges.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and captains commonly describe the POSILLIPO 95S as a fast, adaptable flybridge yacht used for week-long Greek island charters, family Mediterranean cruising, and rapid weekend hops. Broker and charter literature consistently reference a five-cabin layout with a main-deck full-beam master, an expansive main salon with a distinct dining area, and multiple exterior social areas. The flybridge typically features a bar, sunpads, and ample seating, while a large swim platform and storage for a tender and jet-skis make the yacht suitable for both charter turnover and private entertaining without excessive crowding on deck.

On the water, listings and captain reports generally place cruise speeds in the

23–27 knot range with top speeds near 29–31 knots, and feedback from the Technema-series community often praises the boat’s solid ride—frequently summarized as “rides well and is constructed like a brick.” That said, operators note that anchoring in strong winds and close-quarter maneuvering require care; a Technema 95 grounding in heavy weather is a cautionary example. Main propulsion is commonly the MTU 16V2000 M93, which benefits from support by trained MTU technicians and diligent attention to fuel systems, injectors, and turbochargers. Fuel burn is a notable operating cost, typically quoted around 600–670 L/hr at common cruise and power settings. Deck and mooring fittings are robust, though some cleat, fairlead, and spring line placements can be awkward and may be adjusted over time, and regular teak and deck maintenance is expected. Condition and service history vary by hull—one charter guest review reported poor upkeep on a listed 95S—so prospective buyers should verify maintenance records and current condition individually.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile usage profile: proven in week-long Greek charters, family cruising, and fast weekend hops.
- Spacious 5-cabin layout with a full-beam main-deck master, large salon/dining, and a sociable flybridge with bar and sunpads.
- Strong performance for a flybridge motor yacht, with roughly 23–27 knots cruise and about 29–31 knots top speed.
- High fuel consumption at typical cruise, with brokers quoting around 600–670 L/hr.
- MTU 16V2000 M93 propulsion demands specialist maintenance and trained technicians.
- Requires vigilant handling and anchoring in heavy winds, with a grounding incident highlighting the risk.
