Opting for the 61 prioritizes a balanced mix of seakeeping and liveaboard versatility. Measuring 61 ft (18.59 m) overall with a 15 ft (4.75 m) beam and a Modified Deep Vee hull, it is tailored to owners who value predictable handling and comfortable cruising at steady speeds. Power comes from twin MAN inboard diesels, the deck is practical in fiberglass, and four onboard heads support longer stays afloat. Q: What defines the 61 in its market segment? A: It sits as a refined motor yacht within the motor yachts class, combining a Modified Deep Vee hull form

with a fiberglass and plastic construction to deliver composed, efficient passages.

Q: What is the cruise speed of the yacht? A: The listed **cruise speed** is 19.12 knots (22 mph), a pace suited to comfortable coastal hops and practical itinerary planning.

Q: What engines power the yacht? A: Propulsion is provided by **twin MAN** engines in an **Inboard** layout running on **Diesel**, chosen for their dependable performance and serviceability.

Q: What are the hull and deck materials? A: The **hull** uses fiberglass and plastic with a **Modified Deep Vee** profile, while the **deck** is finished in Fiberglass for durability and ease of maintenance.

Owner Experience Review

Owners frequently choose the 61 from PRINCESS for family cruising and entertaining purposes. The commonly specified 3-cabin/3-head arrangement with a separate crew/utility berth, together with an expansive flybridge and cockpit outfitted with a sunpad, U-shaped seating and a wet bar, makes everyday life aboard convenient for family use. Many owners also recall confident coastal passages and multiday legs such as runs from Maine to Fort Lauderdale.

Feedback underway is generally favorable: owners describe the boat as “thoroughly enjoyable, well mannered and dependable,” and multiple reports praise the 61 for excellent seakeeping. Performance is influenced by engine choice (brochures list Volvo Penta, MAN, or Caterpillar as options) and overall

loading, with specification sheets suggesting top speeds roughly between 31–35 knots; owners note that fuel consumption and cruising pace can vary significantly with weight and fuel levels.

In terms of comfort and maintenance, the flow from salon to cockpit to swim platform is a strong point, though the crew cabin is often viewed as compact and better suited to children or short stays. Servicing can require effort: several owners indicate deep engine access may necessitate removing the salon couch, carpeting, padding and floor hatches, while others mention a separate cockpit hatch that handles routine inspections. Ongoing upkeep grows with vessel size and systems—larger hull area, substantial engines and optional equipment like twin generators, stabilizers or hydraulic systems add maintenance demands, particularly for older examples that benefit from attentive servicing.

Pros and Cons

- Well-mannered handling and strong seakeeping, commonly described as enjoyable and reliable.
- Family-oriented 3-cabin/3-head layout paired with expansive flybridge and cockpit social spaces.
- Proven capability for coastal passages with adaptable performance depending on engine configuration and loading.
- Engine-room access can be restricted and may require removal of salon elements for deeper maintenance.
- Crew accommodations are compact and better suited to kids or brief overnight use.
- Larger size and additional systems (stabilizers, hydraulics, twin generators if installed) increase routine maintenance, especially as the yacht ages.
