OVERVIEW

Represented by Andrey Shestakov and the team at Shestakov Yacht Sales, the 495 Owners Edition from PRIVILEGE marries the handling and sail performance of a conventional sailing yacht with the steadiness of a catamaran hull, all constructed on a robust fiberglass and plastic foundation. At 49 feet (14.94 m) overall, it is aimed at owners who prioritize elegant, long-distance cruising under sail.

Q: Is the 495 Owners Edition a sailing or power yacht? A: It is a **sailing** vessel — a sailing yacht laid out as a catamaran to increase stability and onboard comfort.

Q: Who is the builder of this model? A: The **builder** is PRIVILEGE, a marque noted for high-quality multihull construction.

Q: What are the key dimensions? A: The **LOA** measures 49 ft (14.94 m), offering an equilibrium of interior volume and manageable handling for owner-operators.

Q: What is the engine setup? A: The yacht is equipped with a single **engine** by **Volvo** (1 x Volvo), ensuring reliable auxiliary propulsion while under sail.

Owner Experience Review

Owners select the 495 Owners Edition from PRIVILEGE as a robust platform for bluewater cruising and liveaboard life. Broker and owner records note full circumnavigations and extended ocean passages, commonly in the three cabin Owner's Edition that prioritizes privacy and comfort. Its shallow draft and capacity for off grid operation make it especially well suited to Bahamas and Caribbean anchorages, while multi cabin configurations also find demand in upscale charter and brokerage markets.

On the water, the bridge deck height reduces slamming in head seas, and the yacht is frequently commended for its steady offshore manners—including successful heavy weather and high latitude passages in some accounts. Sea trials and listings refer to it as “fleet of foot” with straightforward off wind handling; under power it typically cruises near 8 knots and can approach 9–10 knots when required, with competent light air sailing performance.

Aboard, the full beam forward owner's stateroom in the nacelle is notable for its volume, privacy, and storage capacity, paired with a spacious saloon and optional galley up or galley down arrangements suitable for family use or premium charter operations. Cockpit layout and wet bar functionality support sustained liveaboard comfort. Typical maintenance histories mention periodic attention to saildrive seals and zincs, genset hours leading to major servicing or replacement on long range vessels, and engine related refit items such as alternators, injectors, exhaust manifolds, and throttle/transmission cables; access for servicing is aided by piano hinged aft berths and large service hatches.

Pros and Cons

- Proven bluewater cruiser utilized for circumnavigations and long passages.
- Full beam forward owner's suite and an ample saloon enhance private, comfortable liveboard usage.
- Respectable bridge deck clearance, stable offshore behavior, and easy off wind handling with cruising speeds around 8 knots under power and the potential to reach near 9–10 knots.
- Saildrive seals and sacrificial zincs require periodic maintenance and should be confirmed in service records.
- Genset maintenance is a routine consideration on long range examples, with many boats having undergone major service or replacement.
- Boats produced in the mid 2000s to early 2010s commonly enter refit cycles for engine related systems, with some work already completed or due.

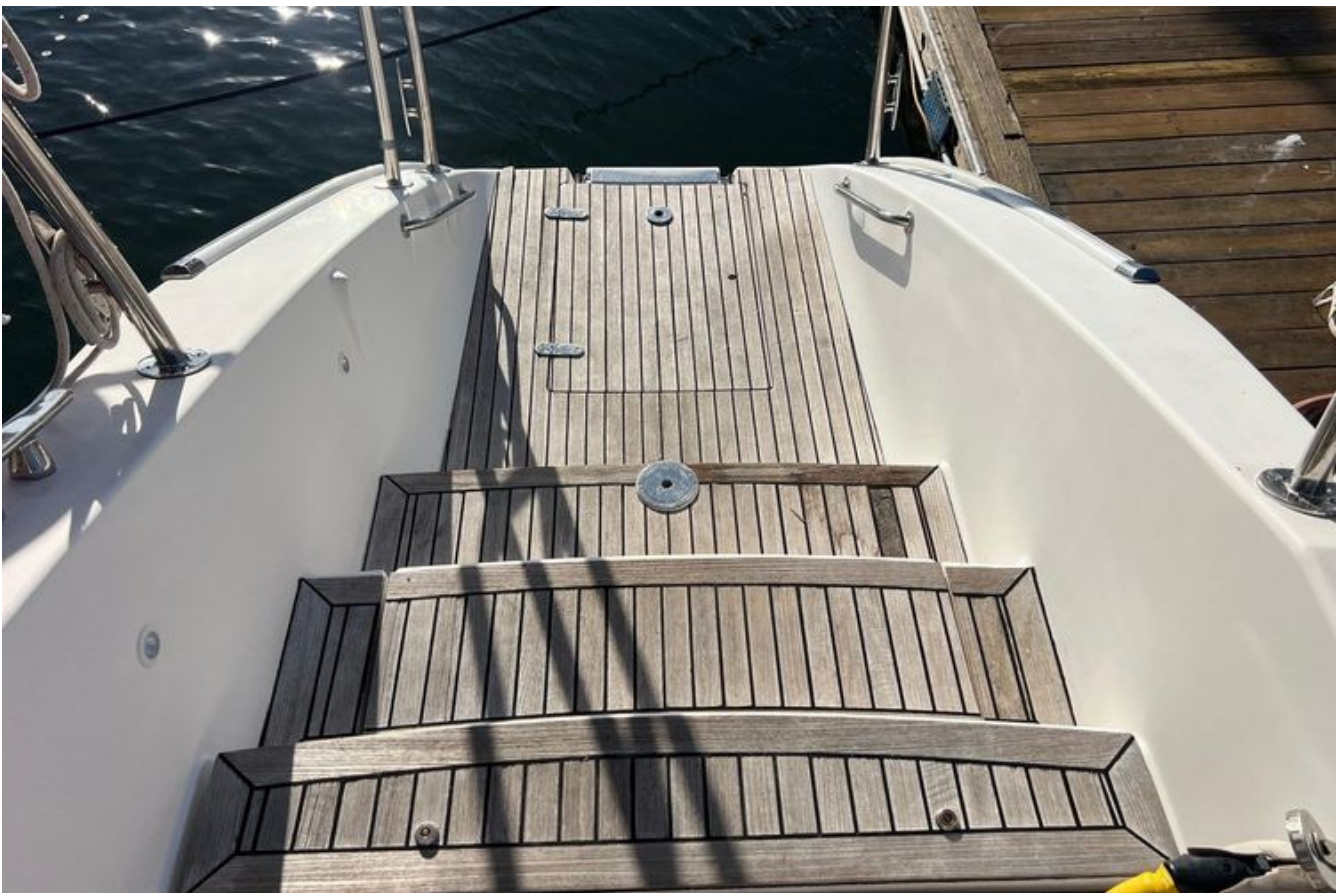
