# OVERVIEW

---

## Selecting a Catamaran

---

Opt for the Catamaran when you need roomy cruising accommodations and comfortable liveboard space: its 49 ft (15.22 m) overall length and 24 ft (7.4 m) beam deliver ample volume and exceptional stability. The layout supports up to 8 people onboard, with 6 berths for sleeping and 2 heads. Twin Volvo Penta Sail Drive diesel engines provide reliable propulsion, yielding a typical cruising pace of 6 kn (6.9 mph) and a top speed around 8 kn (9.21 mph), ideal for steady offshore passages. ## Questions and Answers

---

Q: What powers the Catamaran? A: It is equipped with 2 x **Volvo Penta** engines using **Sail Drive** and **Diesel** fuel for dependable handling.

Q: How fast does it cruise and what is the top speed? A: The **cruising speed is 6 kn (6.9 mph)** and the **maximum speed is 8 kn (9.21 mph)** .

Q: How many people can stay aboard and sleep comfortably? A: There is **accommodation for 8** , with **sleeps for 6** , **2 heads** , and a **crew cabin with 2 berths** .

Q: What are the key dimensions and draft? A: **LOA 49 ft (15.22 m)** , **beam 24 ft (7.4 m)** , and **draft 11.745 ft (3.58 m)** .

Q: What is the hull and deck construction? A: The hull is within the **fiberglass and plastic** category, and the **deck is Fiberglass** ; design is by **Prout** .

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners choose the Catamaran from PROUT for serious blue water cruising and extended voyages, with several accounts of circumnavigations attesting to its offshore capabilities. Underway it behaves as a steady passage vessel rather than a high performance racer; owners report a heavier, more deliberate feel—"the more wind the more she seems to like it"—and some observers have recorded about eight knots around 2,450 rpm.

For families living aboard and for charter operations, the nacelle layout offers substantial saloon headroom and fore and aft living areas, with adaptable interior schemes including 3–4 cabin plans and galley down configurations for owner or charter use. As one owner observed, "They are a lot of boat for their current market price." Maintenance is typical of older cruising cats: inspect for water ingress at deck fittings, examine rudder tie rod zones and bearings, and

check saildrive seals. Engines and systems are generally accessible through large aft hatches, and many boats feature conventional Volvo engines with saildrives—confirm seal condition and review any historical structural or fit out refits for scope and quality.

## Pros and Cons

- Pro: Blue water capable cruiser with owners reporting long passages and circumnavigations.
- Pro: Spacious nacelle with generous saloon headroom and flexible 3–4 cabin layouts, including galley down options.
- Pro: Strong value proposition for space and capability on the used market.
- Con: Heavier and not a performance cat, with more sluggish handling than modern designs.
- Con: Lower bridgedeck clearance on several models can cause slamming when driving upwind in chop.
- Con: Age related upkeep to watch—potential water ingress, rudder tie rod/bearing wear, and saildrive seal condition.
