## Selecting a 325 OS

---

If your priority is a compact yet capable motor yacht that provides secure passage on deck via a walkaround layout and benefits from a fiberglass and plastic hull, the 325 OS by PURSUIT BOATS is a strong contender. With twin Yamaha outboards, an overall length of 34 ft and a 10 ft beam, it's well suited to owners who want confident handling, straightforward upkeep, and a footprint that fits many marinas and slips.

## Questions and Answers

---

Q: What type of yacht is the 325 OS? A: It is a motor yacht configured with a walkaround layout built on a fiberglass and plastic hull, designed to promote safe movement on deck and long term durability.

Q: What are the key performance figures? A: The 325 OS achieves a **cruise speed** of 32 kn (36.83 mph) and a **top speed** of 48 kn (55.24 mph).

Q: Which engines power this model? A: Propulsion comes from two **Yamaha outboard** engines running on **gas** , providing responsive and efficient thrust.

Q: What are the principal dimensions and draft? A: The yacht measures **LOA** 34 ft (10.57 m), **beam** 10 ft (3.3 m), with a **draft** of 8.749 ft (2.6666 m).

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners commonly view the PURSUIT BOATS 325 OS as a do everything boat: it handles family weekend overnights, serves as a serious offshore fishing platform, and doubles as a relaxed sandbar or day boat without feeling overly specialized.

The cabin earns frequent praise relative to the boat's size, offering a forward convertible V berth, a full mid cabin berth, an enclosed head with nearly six feet of headroom, and a compact galley; dual refrigerators are commonly noted as a helpful touch for short cruises. On deck the centerline walkthrough, L shaped helm seating, fold up bolster with fold down captain's step, fold down transom bench, and a cockpit entertainment module (grill/sink) encourage social use, and factory test boats often feature dual 16 inch MFDs at the helm. For anglers, the package includes 12 hardtop rod holders, a transom livewell, and insulated fishboxes to support offshore fishing.

Underway, owners and reviewers report the boat planes quickly and maintains a dry ride, thanks to the hull's 20 degree deadrise and chine flats that redirect spray and cushion chop. Handling is described as solid and predictable in

steep water with an offshore capable demeanor; typical cruising speeds are in the upper 20s to low 30s (knots) and mid 40s for top speed when equipped with twin 350s.

Maintenance notes from owners skew practical: used examples often benefit from comprehensive surveys and engine inspections—particularly attention to Yamaha lower units, exhaust housings, and cooling components on older installations. Electronics and upholstery generally require more upkeep over time than the hull. The 2025 redesign emphasized serviceability, adding larger cockpit access to the machinery space and easier engine servicing. Budget considerations are a recurring conversation among buyers, with some shoppers characterizing the 325 OS as “another league” in terms of price.

## Pros and Cons

---

- Versatile layout that works for offshore tournaments, family weekenders, and sandbar days without feeling compromised.
- Class leading cabin for this size with a convertible V berth, a true mid cabin berth, dual refrigerators, and an enclosed head near six feet.
- Confident, dry ride that planes quickly and stays predictable in chop, with cruise in the upper 20s–low 30s and mid 40 knot potential with twin 350s.
- Purchase budgets are a frequent sticking point, with some shoppers calling the PURSUIT BOATS 325 OS “another league” price wise.
- On used examples, owners recommend rigorous surveys and engine inspections, especially Yamaha lower units, exhaust housings, and cooling systems on older power.
- Electronics and upholstery tend to need more attention over time than the hull, according to owner threads.
