Powered by twin Yamaha outboards running on gas, it offers dependable performance for both dedicated anglers and family cruising. The 345 Drummond Sportfish is ideal for owners who want a manageable 34 ft platform with a 9 ft beam, dependable twin outboard propulsion, a single, functional head, and an ample 300 gallon fuel reserve. As a dedicated sport fisherman built on proven fiberglass construction, it answers the needs of anglers who also value comfortable short cruises.

Owner Experience Review

Owners commonly report that the 345 Drummond Sportfish from PURSUIT BOATS performs well offshore: the ride is frequently described as smooth, dry and solid in a range of sea states, aided by a deep V hull with roughly 24.5° aft deadrise which instills confidence when conditions worsen.

With twin Yamaha F350s, typical cruise performance is reported at about 32 mph cruising at 4,000 rpm, and examples fitted with twin 250s have been logged at nearly 40 knots at wide open throttle—impressive speed figures for a vessel of this length.

The interior arrangement accommodates more than just fishing. A center island cockpit galley with an integrated sink, side loading refrigerator, microwave and stove keeps the cabin uncluttered and supports comfortable day boat hospitality. Down below, the accommodations are notably spacious for a 34' boat, offering about 6'4" of standing headroom, a full size V berth, a generous head, plus a mid berth that doubles as storage—practical for short family overnights.

Common ownership notes include recurring maintenance items: several owners mention persistent fishbox macerator issues and report that deck boxes can allow water entry. Some boats equipped with first generation Yamaha F350/350A powerplants have experienced problems with water/exhaust manifolds and subsequent water intrusion, and a number of owners have also reported intermittent electronics or power distribution

quirks over longer ownership periods.

Pros and Cons

- Smooth, dry ride and a solid offshore character thanks to the deep V hull (~24.5° aft deadrise).
- A flexible cockpit layout with a center island galley and tackle friendly configuration that suits fishing and entertaining alike.
- Cabin volume punches above its class for 34', offering roughly 6'4" headroom, a full size V berth and a roomy head.
- Recurring owner complaints about unreliable fishbox macerator operation.
- Deck boxes reported as not completely waterproof, permitting unwanted water ingress.
- Some first generation Yamaha F350/350A installations have documented manifold water/exhaust failures on certain boats.
