OVERVIEW

The 355 from PURSUIT BOATS is a multi-role motor yacht engineered as a purposeful cruiser. Measuring 35 ft (10.67 m) LOA, she is driven by three Yamaha outboards, built on a fiberglass hull with a fiberglass deck, and provides accommodations for four with a single head, supported by 50 gal of freshwater and 388 gal of fuel.

Selecting a 355

If high-performance outboard propulsion, straightforward maintenance, and the ability to sleep aboard for weekends with family or friends are priorities, the 355 deserves consideration. Triple Yamaha power running on **Gas/Petrol** delivers confidence for coastal runs, while berths for 4 and one head make short cruises practical. Positioned as a cruiser inside the wider motor yacht category, she strikes a balance between dayboat agility and weekend cruising comfort.

Questions and Answers

Q: What powers the 355? A: The boat is driven by three Yamaha **outboards** using **Gas/Petrol** . The installation comprises **three engines** from **Yamaha** , delivering assured propulsion.

Q: How many people can sleep aboard, and is there a head? A: The layout **sleeps 4** and includes **1 head** , making it suitable for overnight trips.

Q: What are the key dimensions? A: Overall length (**LOA**) is **35 ft (10.67 m)** , offering a compact yet capable footprint for a cruiser in the motor yacht segment.

Q: What are the hull and deck materials? A: The vessel is built with a fiberglass hull and a **fiberglass** deck, chosen for longevity and straightforward maintenance.

Q: What are the tank capacities? A: The yacht carries **388 gal** of fuel and **50 gal** of freshwater, sized for comfortable weekend cruising.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and sea-trial reviewers frequently describe the 355 from PURSUIT BOATS as a true crossover machine: roomy family cruising with a luminous cabin and A/C, serious capability for offshore fishing, and an entertaining cockpit for weekends. Hull side glazing and roughly 6'8" of headroom help the cabin feel spacious; the convertible dinette/berth, a full galley, and a stand up head with shower all support extended stays aboard. At the helm, reviewers praise the single piece windshield, the swivel helm seat, and the integrated hardtop for their ergonomics and sightlines, while the wide cockpit, fold away transom seat, L lounge, and hardtop awning make switching from fishing mode to socializing straightforward.

On the water, owners report the hull powering through Gulf chop with responsive handling and tight turn control from its modified V configuration. Acceleration is brisk—test figures note reaching 30 mph in about 12 seconds and exceeding 46 mph at full throttle—while typical cruise speeds sit in the mid 30s mph, with many operators finding an efficient band around 15–24 knots. Rigging choice changes the character: twin versus triple Yamahas produce different responses, and some twin engine owners say they would prefer additional horsepower. Anglers highlight the practical fit out—flush

in sole fish boxes, a 28 gallon livewell, and under gunwale rod stowage—and the transom wings that permit access to tilted props for at sea adjustments. Routine ownership resembles other Yamaha powered express boats, though forum discussion flags occasional trim tab pump voltage dips that can upset electronics; consistent attention to impellers, battery systems/chargers, trim tab maintenance, and livewell/plumbing care follows the owner's manual recommendations.

Pros and Cons

- Bright cabin with hull side windows, ~6'8" headroom, full galley, A/C, and stand up head/shower enable comfortable multi day family cruising.
- Confident ride and handling in chop with strong acceleration, mid 30s mph cruise, and over 46 mph top end performance.
- Offshore ready fishing layout with in sole fish boxes, a 28 gal livewell, and under gunwale rod storage.
- Reports of trim tab pump voltage dips can cause intermittent electronics glitches.
- Some owners on twin engine packages wish for more horsepower compared with triples.
- Ongoing outboard and systems upkeep—impellers, batteries/chargers, trim tabs, plumbing, and livewell—requires consistent attention.
