## OVERVIEW

---

The 378 from PURSUIT BOATS is a motor yacht in the center console class, built on a fiberglass and plastic platform. Offered through Andrey Shestakov and Shestakov Yacht Sales, it pairs triple outboard propulsion with modest overnight accommodations for a single guest.

## Selecting a 378

---

Opting for the 378 means aligning your needs with a flexible center console yacht. With an LOA of 37 ft (11.28 m) and a 12 ft (3.66 m) beam, the hull proportions inspire confidence, while three Yamaha outboards together with a 427 gallon fuel reserve support extended passages. The single berth and one head accommodate pared down overnighting. If you seek a motor yacht built on a sturdy fiberglass and plastic hull that leverages outboard efficiency, the 378 merits a detailed look with Shestakov Yacht Sales.

- What type of yacht is the 378? The 378 is a motor yacht in the center console category built on a fiberglass and plastic hull.
- Who is the builder of the 378? It is produced by PURSUIT BOATS, combining triple Yamaha **engines** with efficient outboard design and operation.
- What are the key dimensions of the 378? **LOA** is 37 ft (11.28 m), **beam**

measures 12 ft (3.66 m), and **draft** spans from 8.475 ft (2.5833 m) to 10.389 ft (3.1666 m).

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners select the 378 from PURSUIT BOATS because it serves a dual purpose: comfortable family outings and short overnight trips, as well as lively weekend entertaining. The belowdecks area frequently earns praise for its livability—air conditioning, a dinette that converts to a berth, tasteful wood trim, and a stand up head make extended runs and evenings with children aboard manageable and comfortable. On deck, the electric sliding aft entertainment center complete with sink, grill, and refrigerator, along with plentiful seating and flexible lounge arrangements, streamlines hosting and socializing.

Underway, owners report a composed, reassuring ride in choppy conditions and an overall predictable handling character; many credit the hull's shape and its 22° deadrise for that secure, planted sensation. Typical performance notes include about 44 mph at roughly 4500 rpm when equipped with triple Yamaha F425/450 XTO engines, and the ability to exceed 60 mph at full throttle. Anglers appreciate the practical fishing features—large fish boxes, a roomy livewell, and generous rod storage—making serious offshore day trips feasible without sacrificing family comfort.

Maintenance realities reflect the boat's capability: three outboards mean triple the routine engine servicing plus regular attention to propellers, steering

linkages, and fuel system components. The outboard configuration provides easy access at the transom for many checks, but significant repairs on three large engines often require adequate dock space, a lift, or time in a yard; dealer service is a common recommendation. Add on systems such as a Seakeeper gyro and a generator improve comfort and stability but also introduce extra service intervals; many owners tap the active Pursuit owner community for setup advice and maintenance best practices.

## Pros and Cons

- Smooth, predictable ride and balanced handling in chop, helped by a 22° deadrise hull.
- Flexibility to switch between family cruising, entertaining, and offshore fishing with genuine angling amenities.
- Cabin conveniences (A/C, convertible berth, stand up head) and an electric sliding entertainment center enable comfortable overnighting and social use.
- Triple outboards increase routine service costs and complicate scheduling.
- Optional Seakeeper gyro and generator introduce additional maintenance tasks and service intervals.
- Major engine work commonly needs dock space, a lift, or yard time, with dealer service often advised.
