Owner Experience Review

Owners and charter operators typically describe the CAYMAN 26 from RANIERI as a purpose-built dayboat: perfect for coastal cruising, island-to-island hops, watersports sessions, family outings, and short snorkel or dive run operations. Many are used in charter fleets, where guests frequently praise its composed ride in choppier water and the presence of ample, quiet propulsion. Professional trials often note a sporty, sharply profiled hull that handles admirably for a 26' RIB.

Underway, the CAYMAN 26 reaches plane quickly and delivers a confidence-inspiring, consistent feel. Published test figures commonly show about 12 kt at roughly 2200 rpm, around 20 kt at 3000 rpm, roughly 30 kt at 4000 rpm, and peak speeds approaching 45 kt when fitted with a 250 hp test engine; comfort is generally maintained in moderate chop up to approximately 0.5 m. The Sport Touring layout is tailored for day use: a central console sized to include a dressing/head compartment in the ST variant, expansive bow and stern sunpad areas, and a helm ergonomics that function well both seated and standing.

Practical day-cruising amenities are well covered, with charter listings often highlighting features such as a freshwater shower, USB charging points, and an electric windlass. Owner maintenance is typical for outboard-driven boats in the 175–250 hp range—regular servicing, anode replacement, tube maintenance, and antifouling are standard. Users appreciate accurate fuel-consumption readouts; however, a charter incident involving missing screws on an awning frame (resulting in a canopy collapse) underscores the

importance of routine hardware inspections. Publicly available long-term owner write-ups are limited, but there is no broad forum evidence suggesting persistent structural defects.

Pros and Cons

- Planes quickly and presents a sporty handling character; tests cite ~12 kt at ~2200 rpm, ~20 kt at 3000 rpm, ~30 kt at 4000 rpm, and about 45 kt with a 250 hp test engine.
- Comfortable and steady in moderate chop (around 0.5 m), with charter guests often noting a smooth ride and abundant, quiet power.
- Sport Touring arrangement offers generous bow and stern sunpads, a console designed to house a dressing/head in the ST version, and day-use conveniences (freshwater shower, USB ports, electric windlass) plus reliable fuel-consumption instruments.
- Optimal comfort is usually within seas up to roughly 0.5 m—conditions beyond that call for reduced speed.
- A charter report detailed missing screws on the awning frame leading to a canopy collapse, highlighting the need for regular checks of external fittings.
- Most public feedback stems from short-term charter use, so long-term owner data is limited publicly, though there are no widespread reports of structural failures.
