Q: What kind of engine does it use? A: The boat is powered by a single **Yamaha Outboard** using **Gas/Petrol** , providing a 28-kn cruising speed and up to 35 kn at full throttle.

Q: How is the boat classified? A: It's configured as a versatile motor yacht with a sportfishing role and rides on a fiberglass and plastic hull.

Q: What are the key dimensions and capacities? A: LOA 24 ft (7.32 m), beam 8 ft (2.59 m), draft 5.906–9.186 ft (1.8–2.8 m), fuel 75 gal, water 18 gal, and 1 head.

## Owner Experience Review

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Owners and reviewers commonly regard the 24' LX4 from Regal as an upscale day boat for family outings, sandbar gatherings, and short weekend cruises, with many examples outfitted for tow sports using Yamaha 250–300 outboards and towers. On-water evaluations describe it as intuitive and confidence-inspiring to pilot, delivering precise handling and steady manners in calm seas and light chop. The FasTrac hull is often credited with quicker planing and improved fuel efficiency, while 250–300 horsepower rigs produce strong hole-shot and a comfortable cruise. That said, community posts from older 24' Regal owners warn that lower-powered setups can feel marginal.

Inside, the design emphasizes all-day flexibility: wraparound bow seating, a convertible aft lounge with slide-away capability, and an enclosed freshwater head extend comfort beyond short trips. Owners and dealers praise the deep lazarette and plentiful storage, and the multi-position UltraLounges expand usable cockpit area for beaching or entertaining. Helm layout receives consistent compliments for feeling roomy for a 24' craft, and common

equipment includes dual Garmin displays and a double-wide helm seat.

Typical ownership revolves around standard outboard propulsion (commonly Yamaha F250–F300), regular Yamaha maintenance intervals, and service through dealer networks and warranty channels. For pre-owned purchases, forums and dealers alike recommend a professional survey and verification of power setup and maintenance records. These viewpoints combine expert road-tests with dealer and owner listings; actual performance and comfort will vary by load, sea state, and rigging choices.

## Pros and Cons

- Sharp handling and a stable ride in smooth water and light chop, with the FasTrac hull improving acceleration and fuel efficiency.
- Versatile dayboat layout featuring wraparound bow seating, an enclosed head, and a slide-away aft lounge that opens the cockpit.
- Strong acceleration and a solid cruise feel when equipped with Yamaha 250–300 outboards, appropriate for tow sports.
- May feel underpowered if not outfitted within the commonly recommended 250–300 hp range.
- Ownership requires routine Yamaha outboard service intervals and periodic dealer visits.
- When buying used, confirm power configuration and service history with a survey to prevent surprises.
