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## OVERVIEW

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Compact, quick, and precisely engineered, the 23 from REGULATOR is a motor yacht in the center console category built on a fiberglass hull. Offered by Andrey Shestakov of Shestakov Yacht Sales, this model cruises at 29 knots (29 mph) and can push to 48 knots (48 mph) powered by twin Yamaha gas outboards.

## Selecting a 23

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Opt for the 23 when you want a compact center-console platform that delivers confident performance with uncomplicated ownership. Measuring 27 ft (8.38 m) overall with an 8 ft (2.59 m) beam and fitted with twin Yamaha outboards, it strikes a balance between brisk speed and straightforward operation. The boat's 149-gallon fuel tank, 20-gallon freshwater tank, and single head make it well suited to full days at sea. The interior, penned by Lou Codega, reinforces the motor yacht function and practical layout of the model.

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Q: What speeds does the 23 achieve? A: The 23 maintains a **cruise speed** of 29 kn (29 mph) and can attain a **top speed** of 48 kn (48 mph).

Q: What engines power this center console? A: Propulsion comes from **two Yamaha outboard** engines using **gas** as fuel, providing dependable power and performance.

Q: What are the key dimensions and draft figures? A: The boat's **LOA** measures 27 ft (8.38 m), the **beam** is 8 ft (2.59 m), and **draft** ranges from 5.741 ft (1.75 m) to 9.296 ft (2.8333 m).

Q: What is the construction and layout? A: This model is a motor yacht built with a fiberglass hull and fiberglass deck, arranged in a center console format and fitted with **1 head** .

## Owner Experience Review

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Owners commonly push the 23 by REGULATOR on extended offshore runs and for long day trips; multiple owners report comfortable 50–60 mile passages on the 23 FS layout with a consistently smooth, confidence-inspiring ride. The deep V hull (reported around 24° at the transom) cuts through breaking seas and maintains predictable tracking, and independent reviews routinely praise it as a high-performance fishing platform with responsive throttle behavior at cruise.

Outside of angling, many proprietors utilize the 23 for family beach days and occasional short overnight stays. Fit and finish are often described as above-average for the size, the deck layout is functional, and on select model years or FS variants small cabin/head arrangements provide sheltered accommodations; one owner summed their impression as “everything is VERY solid.”

Practical ownership notes are straightforward: the boat is built stoutly but is noted to “tow heavy” when trailered or moved overland; numerous earlier 23s left the factory with twin Yamaha 150 two stroke engines that owners recall as thirsty and sometimes difficult to start after long periods of inactivity, so many have chosen to repower with modern four stroke outboards. Owners also point out distinctions between the original 23 and the 23 II—highlighting differences in fuel capacity and maximum horsepower (roughly 150 gallons versus about 184 gallons on the II), factors that influence range and maintenance planning.

## Pros and Cons

- Deep V ride (about 24° deadrise reported) that cleaves through capping waves and remains composed in chop.
- Surefooted, stable handling with a responsive throttle and reliable tracking.
- Functional, well-executed layout with a compact cabin/head option on some variants for brief overnighting.
- Heavy to tow, demanding more care and equipment when trailering or transporting.
- Original twin Yamaha 150 two stroke packages are fuel-hungry and can be temperamental to start after long idle periods.
- Distinctions between the original 23 and the 23 II in fuel capacity and maximum horsepower add complexity to decisions about range and service intervals.

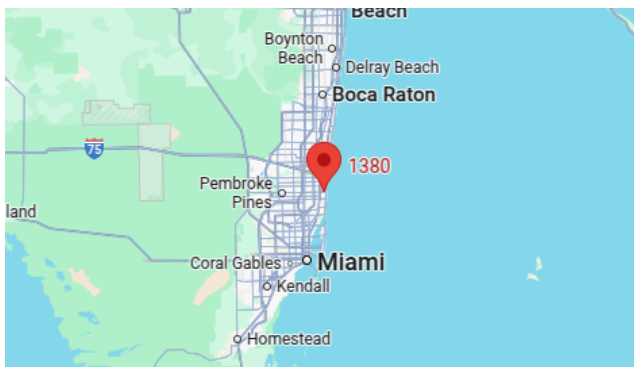
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
