Built with a fiberglass and plastic construction and a proven Deep Vee hullform, it offers confident seakeeping and a practical layout. Offered through Shestakov Yacht Sales with broker Andrey Shestakov, the design balances solid offshore manners with amenities that support both anglers and family outings.

Its Deep Vee hull and twin Yamaha outboards, together with a substantial 10 ft beam, deliver stable behavior and roomy onboard spaces; a private head and other conveniences make long days on the water far more enjoyable for guests and crew. Q: What type of boat is the REGULATOR 31? A: It is a center console yacht that also qualifies as a motor yacht, featuring a **Deep Vee** hull and constructed with a fiberglass and plastic structure.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and reviewers characterize the 31 from REGULATOR as a purpose-built offshore craft that still adapts well to family-oriented day use. Feedback highlights the hallmark soft, dry feel of the deep-V hull, predictable straight-line tracking, and a light, confidence-inspiring helm when threading inlets or running in beam seas. This blend suits tournament anglers while

remaining accessible to owners who prioritize weekend cruises and family outings; durable construction and solid resale values further attract owner-operators and charter operators.

Deck impressions emphasize a cockpit that feels roomier than many peers—tests reference approximately 90 sq ft—supported by ample fishboxes and flexible leaning-post/tackle-center arrangements. The forward V-seat with an optional filler or table quickly converts between casting platform and sociable seating, and the helm receives praise for unobstructed sightlines, capacity for twin large Garmin displays, and well-thought-out storage and switch ergonomics. The perceived “big-boat” ambience (with bracket, LOA can feel closer to ~36'+) contributes to onboard livability and storage beyond typical expectations for the 31-ft class.

Performance notes point to efficient cruising in the planing range when prop selection and load are optimized—one test recorded about 26.4 mph at 19.5 gph (~1.35 mpg)—with strong potential top speeds given the correct power. Owners frequently discuss fuel consumption differences as newer engine packages (such as XTO/450s or G2 variants) and prop choices alter economy. Routine ownership reflects twin-outboard realities: more consumables and lower-unit servicing than single-engine counterparts, and modern integrations like Yamaha digital controls/Helm Master and factory Garmin systems that simplify use but often require dealer-level diagnostics; optional Seakeeper installations also introduce additional service items and added weight.

Pros and Cons

- Soft, dry Deep V ride that tracks confidently and handles well through inlet chop and beam seas.
- A cockpit designed for anglers with large fishboxes and adaptable forward seating that converts for family comfort.

- Helm ergonomics and integrated electronics give a larger-boat impression in the 31-ft segment.
- Twin outboards increase routine operating and maintenance costs versus similar single-engine boats.
- Fuel consumption is a common owner consideration and varies significantly with engine package, prop selection, and load.
- Factory-integrated digital controls, Garmin systems, and optional Seakeeper installations require dealer-level diagnostics and add service interfaces and additional weight.

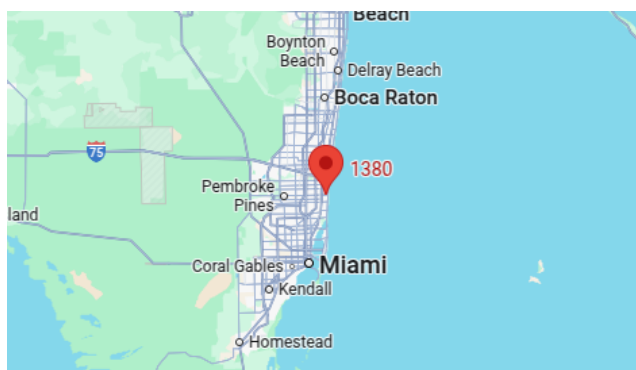
