OVERVIEW

The 2008 built by RICHMOND YACHTS is a 142 ft (43.28 m) luxury motor yacht designed for the upper tier of the motor yachts market. Launched on a sturdy fiberglass and plastic hull with composite deck construction and interior/exterior styling by SetzerPavlik Design Groups, this yacht delivers a comfortable cruise speed of 12 knots and a top speed of 17 knots.

Selecting a 2008

Opting for the 2008 means selecting a yacht focused on volume, onboard comfort, and the established workmanship of RICHMOND YACHTS. The vessel is laid out to host up to 12 guests, includes seven heads, and provides four crew cabins—making it well suited for extended bluewater voyages or refined private entertaining. Large-capacity tanks (11,300 gallons of fuel and 1,584 gallons of fresh water) paired with twin Caterpillar inboard diesel powerplants enable confident long-distance cruising.

Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the 2008? A: It is a luxury motor yacht within the wider motor yachts category, constructed on a fiberglass and plastic foundation engineered for **strength** and **longevity** .

Q: Who designed the yacht's exterior and interior? A: Both the hull and the interior layout were produced by **SetzerPavlik Design Groups** , delivering a unified visual language and **optimized layouts** .

Q: What are the performance figures? A: The 2008 maintains a typical cruise of **12 knots (13.81 mph)** and a top speed of **17 knots (19.56 mph)** , striking a balance between **efficiency** and onboard comfort.

Q: How many people can it accommodate? A: The vessel is configured for **up to 12** guests, serviced by **7 heads** , with space for **4 crew cabins** to support elevated service standards.

Q: What propulsion does it use? A: Propulsion is delivered by **2 Caterpillar inboard diesel** engines, noted for their reliability and **long-range capability** .

Owner Experience Review

Owners and captains commonly describe the 2008 from RICHMOND YACHTS as a flexible platform suited to both private ownership and commercial charter operations. Many vessels in the series are booked as fully-crewed luxury charter yachts, while others are managed by owner-operators for extended passage-making. The spacious decks and expansive salon areas make the yacht well suited to hosting both intimate gatherings and larger social events alongside long-distance cruising.

The semi-displacement hull penned by Ward Setzer is tailored for offshore capability and long-range routing. Examples equipped with twin Caterpillar

C32s commonly report a comfortable 12-knot cruising speed and about a 17-knot maximum, with quoted ranges in the neighborhood of 2,850–3,455 nautical miles when run at 10–12 knots. Zero-speed stabilizers are frequently installed and are credited with improving at-anchor comfort as well as seakeeping underway.

Interior comfort reflects the yacht's large-volume design, with standard arrangements offering five guest staterooms accommodating ten guests and crew quarters often housing eight to nine crew members; reported gross tonnage figures range roughly from 328–395 GT depending on the specific hull. Pavlik's craftsmanship, including mahogany and other wood finishes, is frequently highlighted, and many boats in the class showcase generous salons, alfresco dining areas, and sundecks—some outfitted with gym equipment or a hot tub. Publicly available information tends to come from brokers, charter operators, and crew, and searches did not uncover extensive owner-forum records indicating widespread construction defects.

Pros and Cons

- Blue-water capable semi-displacement hull by Ward Setzer with reassuring seakeeping for offshore itineraries.
- Efficient long-range performance, with reported 2,850–3,455 nm range at 10–12 knots and an easy 12-knot cruise.
- Large-volume interior with five-stateroom layout, expansive decks, and a practical beach/swim platform for guest use.
- Routine Cat C32 service and occasional overhauls, plus parts logistics, are the primary engine-room maintenance focus.
- Periodic major refits are common across the series (examples in 2016, 2019, 2022), requiring budget and downtime.
- Upkeep-intensive features like teak decks, zero-speed stabilizers, and large HVAC/galley systems add operating cost and complexity.

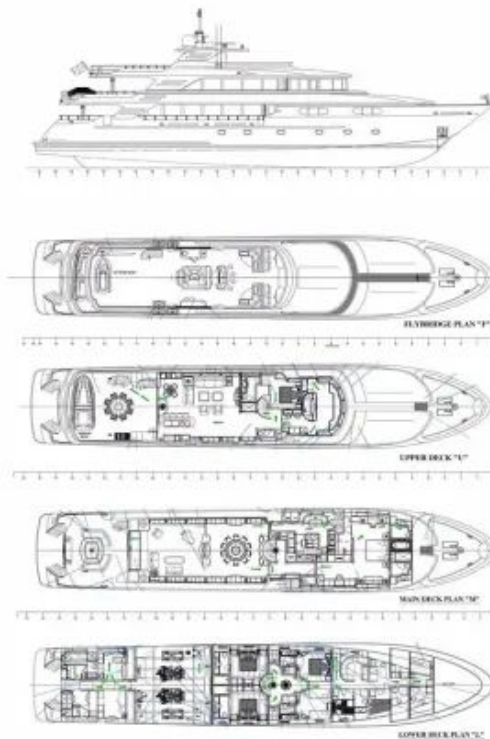
