Selecting a Riva 100 Corsaro

Opting for the Riva 100 Corsaro places emphasis on speed, refined manners and exceptional build quality. With a 98 ft (29.9 m) LOA and a 22 ft (6.7 m) beam it offers substantial interior volume—175 GT—while maintaining lively performance: a comfortable cruise at 24 knots and a top end near 28 knots. As a motor yacht produced by RIVA YACHT, it fuses Italian design expertise with practical long weekend range supported by 2,377.55 gallons of fuel and a usable 348.71 gallons of fresh water.

Features of the Model

- Signature styling and naval architecture: hull conceived by Riva S.p.A with interior schemes by Officina Italiana Design.
- A top tier motor yacht that marries luxurious accommodations with athletic seakeeping.
- Structural highlights include a fiberglass and plastic hull and a GRP deck for an efficient strength to weight ratio and premium surface finishes.
- Propulsion and drivetrain: twin MTU powerplants, inboard installation, running on diesel for dependable thrust.
- Performance figures: typical cruise speed 24 kn (27.62 mph) with a maximum around 28 kn (32.22 mph).

- Guest capacity: set up to welcome as many as 10 people.
- Generous onboard capacities and volumes: 175 GT displacement, 2,377.55 gal fuel reserve, and 348.71 gal fresh water capacity.

Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the Riva 100 Corsaro? A: It is a motor yacht featuring a fiberglass and plastic hull, built by RIVA YACHT.

Q: What are the key dimensions and volume? A: LOA measures **98 ft (29.9 m)** , beam is **22 ft (6.7 m)** , maximum draft is **7.415 ft (2.26 m)** , and gross tonnage is **175 GT** .

Q: How fast does it cruise and what is the top speed? A: The Riva 100 Corsaro typically cruises at **24 kn (27.62 mph)** and can attain a maximum speed of **28 kn (32.22 mph)** .

Q: What powers the yacht? A: Propulsion comes from two **MTU** units configured as **Inboard** diesels, providing robust and reliable performance for the model.

Q: Who designed the yacht's hull and interior? A: The hull was penned by **Riva S.p.A** , while interior layouts and styling were created by **Officina Italiana Design** , reflecting the vessel's Italian design lineage.

Owner Experience Review

Owners typically deploy the Riva 100 Corsaro either as a private family yacht or in charter service, owing to flexible layouts commonly arranged with 4–5 cabins accommodating up to 10 guests and generous communal areas. The model prioritizes alfresco living—featuring an expansive sundeck, dining areas outside, foredeck relaxation spaces and a hydraulically operated beach club/tender garage. Interiors show high end workmanship (walnut joinery, stitched leather, chrome details), but many hulls received extensive customisation, so storage, ergonomics and décor can vary; therefore each individual boat should be assessed on its own specifications. The line launched

with its first hull in October 2016, officially premiered in April 2017, and was produced roughly through 2022 before evolving into the 102' Corsaro Super, meaning available examples cover several different build years.

On the water, twin MTU 16V 2000 package options are reported to give a lively planing character with the classic responsive "Riva" helm feel. Owners and sea trials commonly report comfortable cruising in the 23–24 knot band and top speeds between about 26 and 29 knots depending on fit out, with good stability at speed and a firm ride when encountering chop. Running costs are significant: brokers and charter operators often reference high fuel consumption at cruise (examples cite roughly 600 L/h), and the large MTUs along with hydraulic garages and bespoke owner systems increase maintenance demands. Major mechanical work and warranty servicing are generally handled through Riva/Ferretti authorised centres, which owners rely on for parts supply and technical assistance.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile 4–5 cabin configurations for up to 10 guests make it suitable for family ownership or charter service.
- Generous sundeck, foredeck lounging and a beach club/garage provide strong outdoor entertaining options.
- Sporty planing hull delivers responsive handling and stable behavior at higher speeds.
- Elevated fuel consumption at cruising speeds, with charter and broker reports around 600 L/h.
- Hydraulic garage and customised systems increase mechanical complexity and require specialist servicing.
- Interior fit outs differ substantially between hulls, so ergonomics and storage provisions may not be consistent.

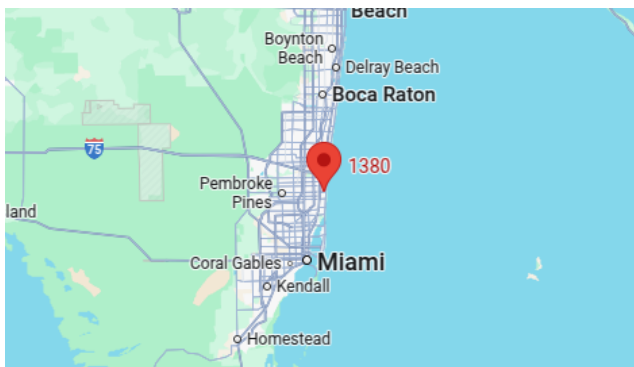
