The 40 Sportfish from Riviera is a purpose-designed motor yacht configured as a dedicated sportfisher. Built with fiberglass and plastic construction on a Deep Vee hull form, it combines twin CAT inboard diesels with sensible tankage and a practical layout to deliver a dependable fishing and cruising platform. Opting for the 40 Sportfish emphasizes a tried-and-true Deep Vee running surface, the dependability of twin inboard diesels, and an uncomplicated onboard arrangement for both angling and living aboard. Shestakov Yacht Sales and broker Andrey Shestakov can help match this model's layout, performance attributes, and specifications to your intended use—whether that's tournament fishing, family cruising, or a blend of both.

Q: What type of boat is the 40 Sportfish? A: It's a motor yacht laid out as a sportfisher, built on a Deep Vee hull with fiberglass and plastic construction.

Q: What powers the boat? A: The model is driven by **twin CAT inboard diesel** engines (2 total) for dependable propulsion.

Q: What are the key **dimensions** ? A: LOA is 40 ft (12.19 m), beam is 14 ft (4.55 m), and draft (min/max) is 13.397 ft (4.0833 m). Gross tonnage is 13.3.

Q: How many people can it **sleep** and how many **heads** are onboard? A: It sleeps **4** , provides accommodations for **7** people in total, and includes **1 head** .

Owner Experience Review

Owners and brokers commonly portray the 40 Sportfish from Riviera as a genuine dual purpose boat: comfortable and family oriented for cruising while remaining fully capable offshore when used as a sportfisher.

The interior layout is arranged to support weekend trips and longer stays, featuring a full galley, a spacious dinette and salon with air conditioning, and a two cabin/one head plan; the L settee in the salon converts to an additional berth. Some listings note household conveniences on board (dishwasher, washer/dryer), and many boats include a protected helm beneath a flybridge hardtop with optional full enclosure to increase comfort in varied weather.

Underway, the Deep V hull earns praise for providing a clean, relatively dry ride through moderate offshore seas and handling that exceeds expectations

for yachts in this size bracket. Examples equipped with larger fuel tanks have been used confidently for longer passages, while the cockpit layout is fishing-centric with features such as a livewell, in-deck fish box, rigging station, freezer, and provisions for outriggers and a fighting chair.

Maintenance experiences vary depending on the installed propulsion—common packages include Caterpillar 3126B, Cummins 6CTA, and Volvo TAMD—and owners highlight differing service intervals and costs. One Cummins-equipped owner reported performing much of his routine maintenance personally, and a magazine sea trial noted the clever, if initially unfamiliar, engine-room access achieved by swinging the bait station aside with a lever. Brokerage records often reference significant 1,000-hour services and generator work, so planning for twin-diesel and genset maintenance is a normal part of ownership budgeting.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile design that doubles as a family cruiser and a capable offshore sportfish.
- Deep-V hull delivers a smooth, dry ride with confident offshore manners for its size.
- Two-cabin layout, full galley, A/C, and a convertible salon settee suit extended family stays.
- Twin diesels and generator entail significant periodic service, including typical 1,000-hour work.
- Engine-room access via the bait-station mechanism can be non-obvious the first time you use it.
- Outriggers and a fighting chair are often options, so full tournament outfitting may require upgrades.
