OVERVIEW

The 50 Sports Motor Yacht from Riviera is a polished motor yacht in the Motor Yacht class built on a fiberglass and plastic yachts hull. Represented by Shestakov Yacht Sales with broker Andrey Shestakov, this 50-foot design delivers a practical blend of cruising range, onboard comfort, and owner-friendly systems.

Selecting a 50 Sports Motor Yacht

Opting for the 50 Sports Motor Yacht keeps size and functionality front and center. Its 50 ft (15.24 m) LOA and 16 ft (5.16 m) beam create roomy accommodations and a stable platform. Twin inboard MAN diesels are specified for dependable thrust and good handling, while two heads, large fuel (872 gal) and water (122 gal) tanks, and a robust fiberglass deck support extended cruising itineraries. As a bona fide motor yacht in the Motor Yacht class, it is aimed at owners who want a family-friendly cruiser with straightforward maintenance.

Q: What are the key dimensions of the model? A: The 50 Sports Motor Yacht features an **LOA** of 50 ft (15.24 m) and a **beam** of 16 ft (5.16 m), giving ample interior volume and a stable ride.

Q: What engines power this yacht? A: The yacht is fitted with **two MAN inboard diesel** engines, chosen for reliable propulsion and accessible service points.

Q: What is the hull and deck construction? A: The hull is categorized under Fiberglass and Plastic Yachts, and the **deck** is constructed from **Fiberglass**, promoting durability and easier upkeep.

Q: What are the fuel and water capacities? A: The **fuel capacity** is 872 gal, while the **water capacity** is 122 gal—capacities that support longer coastal passages and weekend cruises.

Owner Experience Review

Owners are drawn to the 50 Sports Motor Yacht by Riviera because it supports family cruising and entertaining. The layout includes three cabins and two heads with a full-beam master, paired with a single-level salon and galley featuring opposing settees. An enclosed, tri-sided glass flybridge and a sheltered mezzanine expand usable living areas in inclement weather, and the expansive cockpit is well suited to social gatherings and alfresco meals; as Linda Hall observed, "The social areas of the new 50 SMY look beautiful." The foredeck can be configured for tender stowage or converted into a sun-lounging space, and a hi/lo swim platform simplifies launching water toys.

Underway, reviewers praised its driving comfort: they found it "remarkably comfortable to drive" and reported that in choppy seas there was "no hull slap nor any pounding... she just slices right through." Boattest documented a best-economy cruise near 22.6 knots at 2000 rpm consuming about 44 GPH with an estimated range of ~403 NM, and they recorded a top speed close to 33.8 knots. A generous fuel tank (about 872 US gal / 3,300 L) makes weekend and longer coastal runs feasible, and owners can choose joystick IPS

installations or traditional MAN i6 shaft-drives depending on their preference.

Routine ownership is eased by accessible service points and an organized engine room, with features such as double-clamped hoses, tidily supported wiring, and clearly marked mounts. Surveys of 2020–2026 examples revealed no model-specific, recurring failures in the sampled records, though routine maintenance demands will vary by chosen propulsion (IPS 950 or MAN i6). Overall, the 50 Sports Motor Yacht offers a well-rounded brief for families, anglers, and hosts seeking comfortable, weather-capable cruising.

Pros and Cons

- Pro: A roomy single-level salon and a three-cabin, two-head plan with a full-beam master make this layout ideal for family cruising and entertaining.
- Pro: The enclosed flybridge and covered mezzanine create comfortable all-weather gathering spaces, while the cockpit is arranged for alfresco dining or fishing activities.
- Pro: Boattest recorded a best-economy cruise around 22.6 kn with about 403 NM range, and available joystick options simplify owner-operated handling.
- Con: Published performance and range figures are based on test conditions and will change with load, sea state, and condition of the vessel.
- Con: Serious anglers will need to order factory fishing options (rod holders, live-bait well, fold-out seating) to fully outfit the cockpit for dedicated fishing use.
- Con: Selecting between IPS joystick drives and MAN i6 shaft-drive affects handling characteristics and service considerations, requiring careful evaluation.
