OVERVIEW

Purpose-built yet timeless in appearance, the CUSTOM from RYBOVICH measures 75 ft and sits in the motor yacht category of the wider motor yachts market, notable for its traditional wooden hull and finely crafted wood deck.

Selecting a CUSTOM

If you appreciate the feel and performance of classic wooden construction, the CUSTOM warrants serious consideration. Twin Caterpillar inboard diesels drive her to a typical cruising speed of 20 kn (23.02 mph) and a top end around 23.5 kn (27.04 mph), offering capable passage-making while retaining the tactile warmth of a wooden hull. Her 18 ft beam creates generous interior volume, and a substantial 18.045 ft (5.5 m) max draft gives the boat a purposeful seagoing attitude. With three heads, 1,550 gallons of fuel and 500 gallons of freshwater, she is equipped for extended journeys.

Q: What type of yacht is the CUSTOM? A: It is a motor yacht within the motor yachts class, constructed with a wooden hull and finished with a wood deck.

Q: What are the performance figures of the CUSTOM? A: The **cruising speed** is 20 kn (23.02 mph) and the **maximum speed** is 23.5 kn (27.04 mph), providing assured performance for a motor yacht.

Owner Experience Review

Owners favor the CUSTOM from RYBOVICH for serious sportfishing and big-game endeavors, while many also use these yachts for long bluewater passages and private cruising. On the water, these builds are frequently praised as benchmarks for premium custom construction: a fine bow entry cleaves through both flat seas and chop, handling remains sharp at speed, and backing and maneuvering around fish are described as straightforward.

Comfort aboard reflects the shipyard's woodworking heritage: select teak joinery, multiple stateroom arrangements, and upscale galley installations are typical, and bright salons with large glazing create open, sociable interiors. Cockpit layouts strike a balance between hardcore fishing capability and guest comfort, with large fish boxes, mezzanine seating often with A/C, and

abundant tackle storage; helm ergonomics and sightlines on newer builds receive regular commendation. One broker even labeled a custom motor-yacht as among the most distinctive and beautiful yachts they had been involved with, noting how well owner-maintained interiors age.

Ownership, however, carries obligations. Multiple owner reports and documented refits emphasize that maintenance on cold-molded mahogany and other wood customs is more demanding than on similar fiberglass vessels, with routine inspections and occasional structural work necessary; refits commonly include wood replacement, engine and systems repowers, and significant structural upgrades. Serviceability also depends on build era—newer customs typically provide dedicated engine-room access while some older examples require work through the salon—and choice of engine manufacturer (Cat, MTU, Cummins) will affect maintenance regimes.

Pros and Cons

- Sharp bow entry delivers a smooth ride in calm or choppy conditions.
- Responsive handling at speed and fishing-friendly cockpit/helm ergonomics enable precise maneuvering.
- Long-range capability is proven on larger customs, with about 1,100 nm at economical cruise reported on a RYBOVICH 82.
- Maintenance is heavier than on similar fiberglass boats, especially with cold-molded construction.
- Wood construction requires vigilant inspection and periodic structural work, with refits often involving wood replacement and repowers.
- Service access varies by era, and some older builds require engine access through the salon.
