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## OVERVIEW

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Built by RYBOVICH, the Express Walkaround is a compact motor yacht engineered for focused sportfishing while retaining classic Cold Molded construction and finish. This model is offered exclusively through Andrey Shestakov and the Shestakov Yacht Sales team.

## Selecting a Express Walkaround

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If your priorities include diesel efficiency, the durability of Cold Molded construction, and a manageable size for active days aboard, the Express Walkaround deserves consideration. With an LOA of 34 ft (10.36 m), an 11 ft (3.53 m) beam, and an interior arranged to sleep 2 with 1 head, it serves as a capable motor yacht within the sport-fisherman marketplace.

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- Cold Molded hull and deck delivering structural integrity and a refined ride
- Twin Cummins inboard diesel propulsion (2 engines)
- Compact overall dimensions that simplify handling and docking
- 276 gal fuel capacity to extend offshore time between refuels

- Hull designer: RYBOVICH

## Questions and Answers

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- Q: What type of yacht is the Express Walkaround? A: This model is a **motor yacht** classified as a **sport-fisherman** , intended for focused offshore fishing activities.
- Q: Who is the builder of this model? A: The **builder** is RYBOVICH, a yard recognized for Cold Molded construction techniques and careful fit-and-finish standards.
- Q: What are the key dimensions? A: **LOA 34 ft (10.36 m) , beam 11 ft (3.53 m) , and max draft 9.296 ft (2.8333 m) .**
- Q: What powers the boat and what fuel does it use? A: Propulsion comes from two **Cummins inboard diesel** engines, chosen to suit the model's offshore-oriented mission profile.
- Q: What onboard amenities support overnighting? A: The accommodation

plan **sleeps 2** , includes **1 head** , and is built around a **Cold Molded** hull and deck with a hull designed by RYBOVICH.

## Owner Experience Review

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Owners frequently select the Express Walkaround from RYBOVICH as a versatile platform for light-tackle bluewater fishing that still suits the owner-operator who wants offshore day trips and occasional weekend stays. Listings and owner histories across the 34'–44' range show this dual-purpose use, and some examples were sold or optioned to blend entertaining and cruising conveniences with authentic fishing capability.

Sea trials show the boat handled a 4-foot chop with composure at approximately 20 knots and achieved about 33.6 knots at 2250 rpm. Reviewers attribute the yacht's predictable handling, steady tracking, and dry, nimble turns to the Donald L. Blount & Associates hull. Observers noted a relatively high running attitude when accelerating out of the hole; RYBOVICH addressed this on reviewed boats by fitting running-angle wedges. One high-speed backdown test produced a slide to port that was subsequently traced to a deployed port trim tab caused by a malfunctioning tab switch—an equipment fault rather than a hull characteristic.

On 42-foot versions, owners praise the roomy cockpit (a 15'4" beam is often mentioned), teak appointments, an integrated livewell/fishbox, and a tackle-focused console layout that supports serious fishing. Belowdecks, later 42 designs prove practical for overnighting—the portside head is noted for its generous proportions and includes a full stand-up shower. Maintenance expectations reflect the model's custom-oriented pedigree: many boats display documented repowers and engine-room refits, routine service points are accessible thanks to a large helm-deck hatch, early test boats drew comments about elevated noise levels that some owners address with mitigation

measures, and older or highly customized builds commonly require periodic systems upgrades with refit/service costs that can exceed those typical of production walkarounds.

## Pros and Cons

- Ideal platform for light-tackle bluewater fishing and well suited to owner-operator day trips plus weekend overnights.
- Predictable handling with excellent tracking and dry, agile turns, attributed to the Donald L. Blount & Associates hull.
- Generous 42' cockpit (15'4" beam) and a fishing-focused layout complemented by a practical cabin/head for overnights.
- Tendency toward a fairly high running attitude on takeoff, which RYBOVICH mitigated on reviewed boats with running-angle wedges.
- Early test examples exhibited higher sound levels, so some hulls may benefit from targeted noise and vibration reduction.
- Older or custom-built examples often need periodic systems upgrades and can incur higher refit and service expenses than production walkaround models.

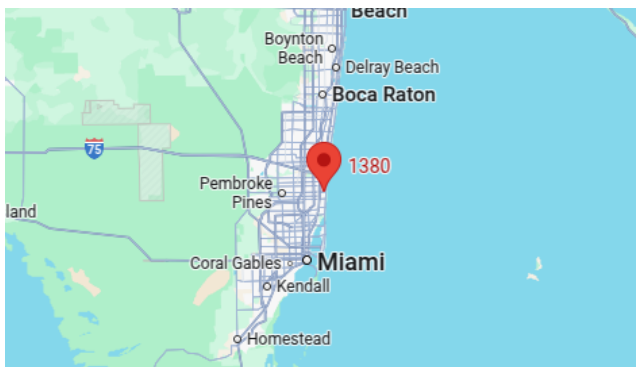
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
