Owner Experience Review

Owners commonly use the 1900 BB Bay Boat from SAILFISH for inshore and bay fishing excursions, typically taking day trips that combine family cruising with casting. Specs and owner manuals frequently reference seating capacity of roughly six, an ample cockpit, and convenience features such as a bimini and stereo that enhance short outings. Storage capacity is ample, and anglers appreciate the 16-gal baitwell along with a 30-gal aft livewell. While usage is predominantly inside bays, some owners do take occasional short nearshore runs when conditions allow.

On the water the 1900 BB Bay Boat is noted for delivering a steady, dependable ride in light chop, helped by its 18° deadrise hull form. Performance is noticeably influenced by propeller choice and trim settings: owners frequently discuss finding the right prop to trade off between hole-shot and top-end speed, and setups that are poorly matched can have difficulty getting onto plane. Routine upkeep centers on standard Yamaha outboard service tasks such as water-pump checks and scheduled maintenance, as reflected in owner feedback. The consensus describes the boat as "versatile and durable," provided the propeller and overall setup are optimized for load and sea state.

Pros and Cons

- Predictable ride in small chop thanks to an 18° deadrise hull.
- Versatile for inshore fishing and family day trips with seating for about six.
- Generous storage plus a 16-gal baitwell and 30-gal aft livewell support active fishing days.
- Sensitive to prop and trim; mis-propped boats may struggle to get on plane.
- Suited to bays and short nearshore hops rather than extended offshore use.
- Dialing in hole-shot and top-end often requires experimenting with propeller choice.
