## OVERVIEW

---

The 260 LXF from SCOUT BOATS pairs upscale finishes with practical performance in a center console motor yacht format built on a fiberglass platform. Measuring 26 ft overall with an 8 ft beam, powered by a single Yamaha outboard, equipped with ample fuel capacity and a dedicated head, it's a capable, confident option for varied days on the water.

## Selecting a 260 LXF

---

Opt for the 260 LXF when you want a nimble motor yacht that retains the simplicity of a center console arrangement. Its 26 ft (7.92 m) length and 8 ft (2.72 m) beam, single Yamaha propulsion, 146 gallon fuel capacity, 20 gallon freshwater tank, and one head deliver a well-rounded package for family outings or active days afloat on a proven fiberglass hull.

- Single Yamaha engine for straightforward, efficient propulsion and easier maintenance
- One head onboard to provide comfort during extended excursions
- Strong fiberglass hull and fiberglass deck for longevity and low upkeep

- Compact, well-balanced dimensions (26 ft LOA, 8 ft beam) in a flexible center console layout

Q: What type of yacht is the 260 LXF? A: It's a motor yacht arranged as a center console on a fiberglass hull, and it includes 1 **head** for onboard convenience.

Q: What is the engine setup on this model? A: The 260 LXF is propelled by a single **engine** supplied by **Yamaha**, keeping operation and upkeep

uncomplicated.

Q: What are the key dimensions of the boat? A: LOA is **26 ft (7.92 m)** , beam measures **8 ft (2.72 m)** , and the maximum **draft** is **5.468 ft (1.6666 m)** .

Q: What are the fuel and water capacities? A: The yacht carries **146 gal of fuel** and **20 gal of water** , enabling extended day trips.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners and reviewers frequently praise the 260 LXF from SCOUT BOATS as a genuine dual purpose platform. The cockpit is laid out for immediate fishing use, with in floor fishboxes, a livewell, rod storage, and hardtop rod holders, while the leaning post is designed for bait prep and organized storage to keep the deck tidy. For family outings, the forward lounge offers comfortable seating beneath an integrated hardtop, and the included 45 qt cooler is a handy addition.

Underway, the standard Seakeeper Ride noticeably reduces pitch and roll, making the boat more composed in chop and increasing skipper confidence. The hull's pronounced flare helps deflect spray, so occupants stay drier, and cruising speeds commonly sit in the low 30s mph depending on the chosen power package. A stepped console with a finished interior and a porcelain head expand onboard comfort for long days and occasional short overnight stays.

From an ownership perspective, the manufacturer's manual stresses rinsing powder coated frames and hardtop fittings after saltwater exposure to prevent corrosion at fasteners. Owner feedback also mentions intermittent

electrical quirks and some corrosion on metal fittings that should be monitored. Additionally, while the Seakeeper Ride improves comfort, it introduces extra system complexity and specific service/diagnostic requirements compared with simple trim tabs, so arranging capable support is recommended.

## Pros and Cons

- Standard Seakeeper Ride meaningfully cuts pitch and roll for a steadier ride in choppy conditions.
- Hull with substantial flare sheds spray well, keeping the cockpit drier for crew and family.
- Flexible layout supports both fishing and family use: roomy forward lounge, livewell, in-floor fishboxes, and clever storage solutions.
- Powder-coated frames and hardtop hardware need thorough freshwater rinsing after salt exposure to avoid corrosion around fasteners.
- Owner reports note occasional electrical gremlins and corrosion on metal fittings that warrant attention over time.
- The Seakeeper Ride system adds operational complexity and ongoing service/diagnostic needs compared with simple trim tabs.
