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Opt for the 530 LXF when you want a large, performance-oriented center console from SCOUT BOATS. It pairs a 54 ft (16.43 m) LOA with a 15 ft (4.55 m) beam and is designed to be driven by quad Mercury gas outboards. The model features an open center console arrangement on a fiberglass and plastic hull with a fiberglass deck and includes one head, making it a standout choice among high-end center consoles and contemporary motor yachts.

## Questions and Answers

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Q: What type of yacht is the 530 LXF and who builds it? A: The 530 LXF is classified as a motor yacht featuring a center console layout, and it is manufactured by SCOUT BOATS. **Type** and **Builder** specifications match the official data.

Q: What are the key dimensions? A: **LOA** measures 54 ft (16.43 m) and **Beam** is 15 ft (4.55 m), providing a substantial footprint and generous deck area for a center console design.

Q: How is the boat powered? A: It is driven by **4 Engines** from **Mercury** in an **Outboard** arrangement operating on **Gas**, offering familiar maintenance routines and strong propulsion.

Q: What materials are used for the hull and deck? A: The hull falls into the fiberglass and plastic category, while the **Deck** is constructed of **Fiberglass**,

consistent with premium center console construction practices.

## Owner Experience Review

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Owners and professional testers often describe the 530 LXF from SCOUT BOATS as a true long range center console with acceleration and pace more akin to a sports car. On-water feedback commonly highlights a stable, rangy ride and top end velocity potential in excess of 70 mph; notably, one sea trial recorded 68 mph using five Yamaha 425 XTO outboards. At cruising speeds the helm is reported to be confident and predictable, and many attribute the firm, efficient motion to the carbon/epoxy infused build approach. Coupled with an approximate 875 gallon fuel capacity, the overall package is suited to longer offshore passages when conditions permit.

For everyday use, the yacht style interior (Genesis Interiors) with its two cabin, one head configuration receives praise for weekend comfort and accommodating guests. Protected flybridge seating and a thoughtfully arranged helm provide excellent sightlines for social dayboating, while the expansive self bailing cockpit, sizable fish box capacity, and a fishing centric deck layout support serious anglers. Owners and brokers frequently point to perceived high build quality—one forum commentator even suggested the brand’s “nice quality” reputation understates reality—yet they also advise prospective buyers to be prepared for the maintenance demands of large multi outboard systems.

## Pros and Cons

- Sea trials report a stable, rangy ride with confident handling, including a 68 mph example with five Yamaha 425 XTOs.
- Versatile deck and two cabin, one head layout suit family overnights, day entertaining, and serious angling.
- Long offshore legs aided by approximately 875 gallons of fuel and a carbon/epoxy infused hull noted for efficiency.
- Multi outboard rigs can demand substantial service time and cost, with some dubbing it a “world record for outboard maintenance.”
- Overall upkeep and running costs are higher than average for production center consoles.
- Owners have reported minor gelcoat spiderwebbing on older boats and occasional generator/battery starting complaints.
