Compact yet capable, the 225 XSF from SCOUT translates center console practicality into a contemporary motor yacht silhouette. Its center-console arrangement and time-tested fiberglass-and-plastic hull construction deliver a straightforward, dependable platform for day use. Presented by Shestakov Yacht Sales with broker Andrey Shestakov, the 225 XSF is aimed at boaters who want uncomplicated capability in a compact craft.

### Selecting a 225 XSF

---

When your priorities are simple handling, efficient single outboard propulsion, and an uncluttered center-console deck, the 225 XSF stands out. Measuring 22 ft (6.81 m) overall with an 8 ft (2.59 m) beam, it occupies a modest footprint that's easy to trailer and maneuver. Its single Yamaha outboard and gasoline fuel system make servicing and refueling widely accessible. Q: What are the overall dimensions of the 225 XSF? A: The **LOA** is 22 ft (6.81 m) and the **beam** is 8 ft (2.59 m), giving a compact but stable platform for confident handling.

Q: What powers this model? A: A single **engine** from **Yamaha** —configured as an **Outboard** —running on **Gas** , providing straightforward performance and easy maintenance.

Q: What is the hull and deck construction? A: The **hull** is a fiberglass-and-plastic build, while the **deck** is finished in **Fiberglass** , offering long lasting durability and simple upkeep.

Q: How would you classify the 225 XSF? A: It is a motor yacht featuring a center console design and built on a fiberglass-and-plastic hull.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners commonly describe the 225 XSF by SCOUT as a saltwater ready center-console that splits time between fishing outings and family cruising. Configurable forward seating with bow cushions and finished storage beneath the seats makes transitioning from angling to leisure effortless, and its selection for a major boat club fleet in 2016 highlights its adaptability in shared-use programs.

On the water, reviewers note an economical cruise near 27.1 mph at 4,000 rpm (about 6.4 gph), with a notably flat, dry ride in choppy bay conditions. Owners and testers emphasize predictable handling, a fast time to plane—approximately 3.4 seconds—and brisk 0–30 mph sprints near 6 seconds on single outboard setups; reported top speeds approach roughly 50 mph when fitted with higher power engines.

Comfort and fit-and-finish are strong for a boat of this size: the console seat and the aerated leaning post baitwell support full fishing days, while bow bolsters and cushions make family outings pleasant. Maintenance feedback centers on routine Yamaha outboard service and post use flushing; battery and electronics access via the console and the starboard panels is straightforward, and replacement canvas or the OEM windshield are easy to source. Aggregated owner and forum reports do not reveal any widespread factory system failures.

## Pros and Cons

- Delivers a flat, dry ride in chop with handling that owners and testers find confidence inspiring.
- Efficient cruise performance near 27 mph at 4,000 rpm (~6.4 gph) with quick 0–30 mph acceleration.
- Flexible deck layout: forward seating with cushions, finished under seat storage, plus an aerated leaning post baitwell.
- Limited enclosed accommodations on this 22 foot hull, so it's primarily a day boat.
- Storage capacity is sufficient but smaller than larger boats, limiting gear for long trips.
- Achieving around 50 mph requires higher power outboard options, so top speed depends on rig choice.

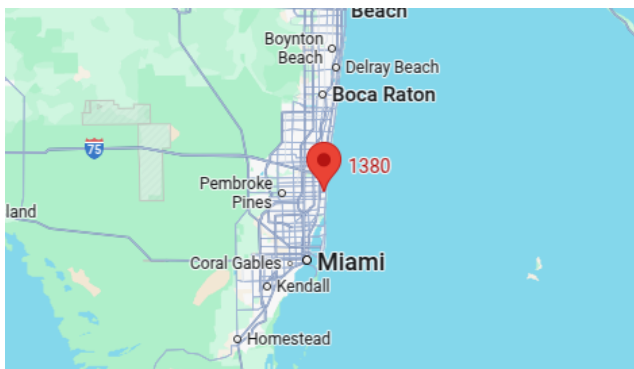
