Measuring an LOA of 19 ft (5.79 m) with an 8 ft (2.56 m) beam, it offers confidence in close-quarters maneuvering and trailerability. Propulsion is provided by a single Yamaha outboard running on gas, favoring efficient operation and simplified maintenance schedules. With a 43-gallon fuel tank, it's configured to support full days on the water without frequent refueling. Built by SCOUT, the model combines reliable construction with practical, everyday performance.

Q: What are the key dimensions of the 195 Sport Dorado? A: The 195 Sport Dorado has an **LOA of 19 ft (5.79 m)** and a **beam of 8 ft (2.56 m)** . As a compact motor yacht, it is designed for easy handling in confined spaces.

Owner Experience Review

Owners of the 195 Sport Dorado from SCOUT typically praise it as a versatile family dayboat, well suited to both coastal cruising and near shore fishing excursions. Its modest size makes it easy to store on a lift or trailer and simple to beach, aided by a 19'5" footprint and a shallow 0.33 m draft, which encourages spontaneous weekend outings.

In performance testing, the boat is reported to get on plane quickly—about 3.6 seconds when paired with an F150—and owners say it handles roughly 1.5 ft of chop with a clean, confidence-inspiring motion. The hull is described as solid and predictable for the class, although it will still exhibit the handling characteristics of a 19 foot boat when conditions worsen beyond typical coastal chop.

Fit and finish receive favorable mentions relative to other small boats, and the day-boat arrangement balances fishing provisions with family-friendly seating and practical storage. Rated to carry around seven people and equipped with a 43 gallon fuel tank, most owners treat the platform as a capable day cruiser rather than an overnight vessel. Routine maintenance is minimal: annual outboard servicing is straightforward, but some earlier boats have recorded minor electrical gremlins and isolated gelcoat or finish issues; a few early owners also noted deck wetness when on plane. As is common with small boats, bilge and service access can feel cramped.

Pros and Cons

- Family friendly layout that suits mixed day cruising and near shore fishing.
- Quick to plane (~3.6 s with F150) with a sturdy, predictable feel in typical coastal chop.
- Above average fit and finish for a 19' boat, with usable storage and seating for about seven.
- Ride comfort is still limited by 19' size when seas build beyond light chop.
- Some owners report minor electrical and gelcoat/finish issues, especially on earlier boats.
- Early feedback included deck wetness on plane, and bilge/service spaces can feel tight.
