OVERVIEW

Built by SCOUT, the 215 Dorado is a compact motor yacht that pairs sensible proportions with uncomplicated power and onboard comfort. At 21 ft (6.53 m) LOA and an 8 ft (2.56 m) beam, fitted with a single Yamaha gas outboard, one head, and an 82-gallon fuel tank, it's designed to be an efficient, low-maintenance platform for days on the water.

Selecting a 215 Dorado

- The modest 21 ft length and 8 ft beam of the 215 Dorado make docking and handling straightforward for owners new to boat ownership.
- A single-engine layout—1 Yamaha outboard (Gas)—keeps systems simple while providing dependable propulsion and easier upkeep.
- Onboard comfort includes 1 head, adding a measure of privacy for excursions that run longer than a quick day trip.
- With an 82-gallon fuel capacity, the 215 Dorado offers notable range for its size, reducing the need for frequent refueling.
- Built by SCOUT and represented by Andrey Shestakov of Shestakov Yacht Sales, buyers get manufacturer quality and experienced brokerage support.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and charter operators frequently pick the 215 Dorado from SCOUT as a capable family dayboat. Its dual-console layout, roomy bow lounging areas, and seating that accommodates roughly nine passengers create a comfortable environment; many find the cockpit surprisingly spacious for what is essentially a 21'6" boat. Practical options such as a teak table, a fold-down transom bench, a port-console head with an optional portable toilet, and a self-bailing cockpit increase its versatility for casual cruising, rental work, or weekend leisure.

On the water, testers note the 215 Dorado turns with confidence and slices through chop effectively, benefits attributed to a 20° transom deadrise. Performance numbers reflect that capability: it planes in about 3.5 seconds, posts top speeds in the neighborhood of 43–46 mph depending on power, and most efficiently cruises near 20 mph at roughly 5 mpg—figures useful for estimating range and fuel costs. For light inshore fishing, the standard rod holders, racks, and a small livewell make it a serviceable fish-and-family platform, though the livewell's modest size limits its appeal to tournament anglers. Owner feedback is mixed: while some applaud the concept and simple

single-outboard layout, others critique aspects of fit and finish—one blunt comment labeled it “lipstick on a pig”—and there’s an anecdotal report of a fuel-sender/gasket failure on an older hull when exposed to ethanol-blend fuel, so prospective buyers of used examples should verify fuel-system components and any retrofits.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile dual-console arrangement that accommodates family cruising, watersports, and light inshore fishing.
- Handling that inspires confidence—carves turns and maintains a smooth ride through chop with a 20° transom deadrise.
- Efficient cruising near 20 mph at about 5 mpg, along with an 82-gallon tank, supports longer day trips.
- Livewell capacity is fairly small (about 19.4 gallons), limiting serious tournament use.
- Owner reports on fit and finish are mixed, with some sharp criticism appearing on forums.
- An owner reported a fuel-sender/gasket issue on an older model when using ethanol-blend fuel.
