OVERVIEW

The 240 XSF from SCOUT is an agile entry in the motor yacht class designed as a center console and built with an aluminum hull. Represented by Shestakov Yacht Sales with broker Andrey Shestakov, it appeals to buyers who want a simple, trailered 23-foot platform powered by a single outboard.

Selecting a 240 XSF

Select the 240 XSF if you prioritize:

- A compact footprint: 23 ft LOA and an 8 ft beam that simplify trailering and storage.
- The ease of ownership provided by a single Yamaha outboard running on gas.
- The efficient, unobstructed deck flow offered by a center console format.
- A durable aluminum build with both an aluminum deck and an aluminum hull classification.
- Essential onboard conveniences, including a single head and a 15-gallon fresh water tank.

Q: What are the overall dimensions of the 240 XSF? A: The **LOA** is 23 ft (7.16 m) and the **beam** is 8 ft (2.56 m).

Q: What is the engine setup on this model? A: It features **1 Yamaha outboard** running on **gas** .

Q: What is the fuel and water capacity? A: **Fuel capacity** is 1 gal, and **water capacity** is 15 gal.

Q: How is the hull and deck described? A: The hull is in the aluminum classification category, and the **deck material** is Aluminum.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and reviewers commonly regard the 240 XSF as a perfectly sized family runabout that balances day cruising and weekend trips with inshore and coastal fishing. The deck layout accommodates both pursuits, offering forward lounge seating, a fold-down transom bench, and sizable integrated livewells that help keep fishing days organized.

On-the-water testing and owner reports place cruise speeds in the 40–50 mph band with a top speed in the mid-50s (around 53–55 mph). Acceleration figures are brisk for the class: approximately 0–20 mph in 4.3 seconds and 0–30 mph in about 6.4 seconds. In light chop, a Sport Fishing reviewer observed the boat “didn’t faze it one iota,” reflecting the model’s quick planing and composed handling.

Comfort and day-to-day practicality are noteworthy for a sub-24-foot center console: the console houses a private head, the bow area is frequently described as “amazingly spacious,” and the cockpit provides generous room for crew and gear, complemented by a full-width swim platform for water access. Routine maintenance is simplified by the single outboard layout, but owner forums have flagged issues such as gelcoat stress cracks on some older SCOUT examples, reports of condensation or standing water in foam-filled or cored

spaces on certain hulls, and community observations that long-term fit-and-finish may deteriorate faster than some competing brands — making a thorough inspection essential.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile platform for family day trips and inshore/coastal fishing with livewells, forward lounge seating, and a fold-down transom bench.
- Rapid to plane and quick for its size, posting 0–20 mph in about 4.3 s and a top speed near 53–55 mph according to performance notes.
- Includes a private head, an unusually roomy bow and cockpit for a 24-foot center console, plus a full-width swim platform.
- Forum reports indicate gelcoat stress cracks on some older SCOUT boats.
- Some owners have reported condensation or standing water issues in foam-filled or cored areas on particular hulls.
- Community feedback suggests that long-term build quality and finish can decline after a few years relative to other brands.
