## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners and reviewers describe the 255 Dorado from SCOUT as a true dual purpose craft: it functions as a fish oriented dual console with a livewell and rod stows while remaining comfortable and welcoming for family day trips. Sea trials frequently highlight a “smooth, solid and uneventful ride,” with

handling that is predictable in typical inshore chop; many reports also emphasize how dry the boat runs. A transom deadrise around 21–21.5° combined with a stiff hull helps the vessel track cleanly and ease short, steep seas, consistent with its CE Category C, nearshore designation.

Comfort and layout are often praised: the boat offers a surprisingly roomy enclosed head with a sink (rare in this size class), aft facing convertible seating that becomes a lounge, fold down benches, and well supportive captain's chairs at an ergonomic helm with clear sightlines. Performance testing has recorded a top speed just over 53 mph with an efficient cruise in the vicinity of 37 mph — enough speed for watersports and quick moves between fishing grounds. Routine maintenance is generally light thanks to modern bonded construction, provided owners adhere to the manufacturer's checks for steering and controls and follow the Yamaha outboard service schedule. Some online discussions note occasional slowness in dealer or warranty response (comments not specific to this model), and as a Category C design the Dorado is best suited to inshore or nearshore conditions rather than offshore passages.

## Pros and Cons

---

- Pro: Smooth, dry and predictable ride in inshore chop, supported by a 21–21.5° deadrise and a stiff hull.
- Pro: Flexible dual console arrangement with livewell, rod storage and convertible seating that accommodates fishing, family cruising and watersports.
- Pro: Generous enclosed head with sink and comfortable helm chairs offering good visibility are amenities uncommon at this length.
- Con: CE Category C designation limits offshore capability; the boat is optimized for nearshore and inshore use.
- Con: Some owners and prospective buyers report slower dealer/warranty

responsiveness in wider forums, though this is not specific to the model.

- Con: Published speed and fuel economy reflect specific test conditions and power/load; actual results will vary in real world operation.
