Owner Experience Review

Owners commonly select the 255 Lxf from SCOUT for its dual purpose

capability: coastal and offshore sportfishing alongside family friendly day boating. Launched in 2015 and remaining active in the resale market into the early 2020s, the model is frequently praised for the NuV3/variable deadrise hull's ability to deliver a soft, dry ride through chop.

Performance feedback notes a responsive throttle and an ability to get onto plane quickly. Factory testing and owner reports indicate an economical cruise band between 3500–4500 rpm yielding around 3+ mpg, with top speeds exceeding 50 mph achievable depending on engine and prop setup.

Deck layout receives high marks for balancing comfort and functionality: a livewell, a 220 qt insulated fishbox, 70 qt forward coolers, under gunwale storage, and an ergonomic helm paired with a deluxe leaning post. The integrated tempered glass hardtop/console enclosure and the optional head with a holding tank expand usability in poor weather and for short overnight stays, though the 255 Lxf is primarily run as a trailerable dayboat.

Routine maintenance is straightforward, focused on outboard service intervals—typical 100 hour or seasonal items include impeller replacement, fuel filter changes, and charging system checks. Owners also advise regular UV protection on darker gelcoat finishes to preserve appearance; resale listings often show low hour, dry stored examples that reflect light, careful use.

Pros and Cons

- Soft, dry ride in chop from the NuV3/variable deadrise hull.
- Quick to plane with responsive throttle and an efficient 3+ mpg cruise band around 3500–4500 rpm.
- Versatile fish/family layout with livewell, 220 qt fishbox, 70 qt coolers, premium seating, and an integrated glass hardtop with a head option.
- Occasional overnight capability only; this is a trailerable day boat, not a true cabin cruiser.

- Dark gelcoat requires proactive anti UV waxing to keep the finish looking fresh.
- Routine 100 hour/seasonal outboard service (impellers, fuel filters, charging checks) is needed to stay ahead of wear.
