Constructed on a resilient fiberglass and plastic hull with a fiberglass deck and driven by a single Yamaha outboard, it blends simplicity, fuel efficiency, and easy upkeep. Selecting a 239 Ultra SE

Opt for the 239 Ultra SE when you want a nimble 24-foot platform that's easy to operate and maintain, with the responsive simplicity of one outboard engine. The center-console arrangement promotes unobstructed deck movement and confident handling, while the 8 ft (2.59 m) beam contributes to a steady ride for family outings or nearshore cruising. Q: What is the overall type of the 239 Ultra SE? A: It is a motor yacht laid out as a center console layout, making the **type** adaptable for day cruising and coastal runs.

Q: What powers the boat? A: A single **Yamaha outboard** running on **gas** , specified as 1 x Yamaha, Outboard, Gas.

Q: What are the key dimensions? A: The **LOA** measures **24 ft (7.39 m)** and the **beam** is **8 ft (2.59 m)** , giving a compact but stable center-console footprint.

Q: What materials are used in construction? A: The hull falls under the fiberglass and plastic category, with the **deck material** finished in **fiberglass** .

Owner Experience Review

Owners who operate the 239 Ultra SE from SEA HUNT commonly use it for family days, sandbar gatherings, and casual fishing trips. The bow area is genuinely accommodating—featuring roomy seating with backrests, bolsters, cupholders and a full-cushion layout—while the stern offers a padded bench, an enclosed console head, a freshwater washdown, and generous in-floor insulated storage/fishboxes that simplify weekend outings.

Anglers appreciate the dual recirculating livewells and abundant rod holders that keep fishing practical for day trips, and one early owner summed up their experience plainly: "Love the boat so far."

On the water, owners and reviewers note a smooth and relatively dry ride for a 23–24' center-console, with predictable handling even when heavily loaded; Lenny Rudow described the helm ergonomics as "works like a piece of cake."

The platform is commonly outfitted with Yamaha engines and can be configured to about 300 hp; many owners report a strong hole-shot and confident cruising performance with 250–300 hp setups. With Seakeeper Ride installed, a September 2023 sea trial on a 239 Ultra SE recorded approximately 53% roll reduction and 60% pitch reduction. Across recent model years (2020–2025) owner impressions have been consistent, though buyers are advised to inspect sink drains for proper overboard discharge, confirm the leaning-post cooler slide extends far enough to open the lid fully, and budget for routine Yamaha four-stroke maintenance and parts.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile layout that accommodates family cruising, sandbar outings, and fishing, with dual recirculating livewells and numerous rod holders.
- Provides a smooth, relatively dry ride and user-friendly helm ergonomics that “work like a piece of cake.”
- With Seakeeper Ride installed, sea trials reported about 53% roll and 60% pitch reduction.
- Confirm that console sink drains discharge overboard to prevent bilge leaks, as noted by owners.
- On some boats the leaning-post cooler slide may not extend far enough to fully open the lid.
- A handful of minor fit/finish or accessory installation items may require attention at delivery.
