OVERVIEW

Purpose-built for flexible days on the water, the 27 Game Fish from SEA HUNT is a center-console motor yacht with a tough fiberglass and plastic hull. Measuring 27 ft (8.33 m) overall with a 9 ft (2.84 m) beam, it comfortably cruises at 35 knots (40.28 mph) powered by twin Yamaha gas outboards. Shestakov Yacht Sales, led by Andrey Shestakov, stands ready to assist with selection, inspection, and purchase.

Selecting a 27 Game Fish

Opting for the 27 Game Fish places emphasis on the uncluttered efficiency of a center console arrangement, the assurance of twin outboard propulsion, and useful onboard features such as a single head. With a 191-gallon fuel tank and a 35-knot cruising pace, it offers a practical compromise for confident dayboating. - Typical cruising speed around 35 knots (40.28 mph)

- What is the cruising speed of the 27 Game Fish? The **cruising speed** is 35 knots (40.28 mph).
- How is the 27 Game Fish powered? Propulsion comes from **twin Yamaha outboards** (2 engines) running on **gas** .
- What are the dimensions of the boat? **LOA** measures 27 ft (8.33 m) and the **beam** is 9 ft (2.84 m).
- What are the fuel and accommodation essentials? **Fuel capacity** is 191 gallons and the boat includes **1 head** .

Owner Experience Review

Owners operate the 27 Game Fish from SEA HUNT across a variety of missions: twin-outboard versions are commonly used for nearshore and offshore trips, while the platform also suits inshore day excursions, light charter work, and family outings. Optional forward seating with filler or a sunpad and an available helm enclosure add family comfort; many listings show a walk-in console with either a porta-potty or an enclosed head. Serious anglers often prefer the coffin-box layout (a large forward fishbox with an integrated livewell), and electronics choices tend to favor Garmin over Raymarine among many owners, despite overall satisfaction with factory systems.

On the water, reviews describe a variable-deadrise hull—approximately 60° at the entry, about 24° amidships, and near 21° at the transom—credited with breaking waves cleanly forward while maintaining calm stability aft. Owner summaries place its riding and fishing capability on par with most other 27-foot boats, and a Seakeeper Ride trial on a 2021 example documented roughly a 56% reduction in roll at 27 mph in light, 1 ft seas, corroborating its composed feel in modest conditions.

Maintenance expectations for this mid-tier twin-outboard boat are predictable: routine service follows standard outboard maintenance schedules, and SEA HUNT dealer support is frequently mentioned in a positive light. Reported concerns include a tight windlass rode basket that can allow rode to pile and jam, intermittent livewell aerator or pump problems reported by multiple owners, and occasional T-top water ingress on some model years with water finding paths through spreader lights or speakers.

Pros and Cons

- Pro: Variable-deadrise hull that splits waves at the bow and remains steady aft; owners report the ride compares well with most 27-foot competitors.
- Pro: Flexible layout options—walk-in console head, bow seating with optional sunpad, and a coffin-box variant—make it suitable for both fishing and family use.
- Pro: A 2021 Seakeeper Ride evaluation showed about a 56% reduction in roll at 27 mph in light, 1 ft seas.
- Con: Windlass rode basket can be restrictive, allowing rode to pile up and potentially jam.
- Con: Multiple owners have reported issues with livewell aerators or pumps.
- Con: Certain model years experience T-top water ingress, with water draining from spreader lights or speakers.
