Q: What powers the Edge 2441? A: It's driven by a single Yamaha outboard; the **engine** is an **Outboard** running on **Gas** .

Q: How large is the boat? A: The **LOA** measures 24 ft (7.32 m), the **beam** is 8 ft (2.59 m), and the **draft** is 4.101 ft (1.25 m).

Q: What categories does this model belong to? A: This model is classified as a motor yacht featuring a center console layout and constructed with fiberglass and plastic materials.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners commonly describe the Edge 2441 from SEA HUNT as a dependable “family fishing boat” that handles weekend leisure outings and inshore/bay angling effectively. It’s frequently used for family cruises and casual sandbar gatherings, and it converts easily to a fishing platform thanks to an open, functional deck and practical storage solutions. The deep V hull is often praised for providing a steady, comfortable ride in choppy water, while the reported 9 foot beam with a generous bow and side entry improves passenger movement and usable deck area. Owners note the boat is suitable for nearshore and occasional day trips up to roughly 40–60 miles when conditions are favorable, but they stress choosing calm weather over pushing into heavy offshore seas.

In operational use, some owners mention a tendency toward bow steer and advise familiarizing yourself with the boat’s handling before relying heavily on trim tabs; a common recommendation is to run without tabs initially and then introduce them to fine tune the hull’s attitude. Typical cruising speeds cited by owners are in the 26–28 mph range, reflecting comfortable, practical cruising rather than maximum speed. Interior volume is designed for dayboats, so owners describe the cabin area as compact and best suited to day use; certain examples display an enclosed head within the console but do not offer a full overnight cabin layout.

Ownership observations are direct: the single engine arrangement simplifies ongoing maintenance compared with twin setups but increases dependence on that sole outboard if assistance is needed offshore. Forum discussions at

the brand level reference concerns like perceived “not enough foam” in some areas and note that limited hull warranty repairs are processed through the manufacturer, occasionally involving transport logistics. Factory packages are often minimal, prompting many owners to add electronics and other upgrades aftermarket. Routine maintenance items frequently mentioned include Lenco trim tab care, scupper flap attention, and replacement of cushions and windshields.

## Pros and Cons

- Deep V hull provides a steady, comfortable ride in choppy conditions suitable for family cruising and fishing.
- The broad 9 foot beam, large bow area, and open deck layout create ample space for anglers and passengers.
- A single engine configuration reduces routine maintenance complexity and typically lowers upkeep costs compared with twin engines.
- Some owners report occasional bow steer, meaning careful adjustment of trim and tabs is necessary to achieve the desired ride.
- Interior accommodations are intended for day use only, lacking a true cabin for overnight stays; many examples include just a console head.
- Owner feedback often cites foam void concerns and relatively basic factory packages that lead to aftermarket electronics/upgrades, with warranty work directed through the factory.
